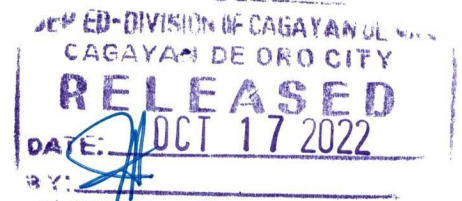

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Sayaw sa galaw, sa Droga Umayaw **Hiphop Dance Contest Mechanics**

The Department of Health Center for Health Development – Northern Mindanao, through the Non-Communicable Diseases Cluster and in partnership with USAID – RenewHealth, shall conduct the Drug Abuse Prevention and Control *Sayaw sa Galaw, sa Droga Umayaw* Hiphop Dance Contest open to invited government high school students in Cagayan de Oro City.

1. The competition is open to ten (10) government high school students dance crew **pre-selected by Department of Education – Division of Cagayan de Oro City**. Only official enrolled students are allowed to join the dance crew. The selected school shall send one (1) dance crew as representative.
2. The dance crew should be a **minimum of six (6) members**.
3. The duration of the dance should be a minimum of 3 minutes and a maximum of 5 minutes. This will already include the entrance and exit.
4. Participants need to create their own Medley HipHop Dance music and using any kind of hiphop dance is allowed (locking, popping, krump, house, stepping, wacking, tutting, voguing, party dances, hiphop choreography) or any kind of dance with hiphop as their focal thought of choreography, provided that the choreographers of the group have the proper knowledge or background to execute it properly. In their dance they need to incorporate the concept on "**Say yes to life and say no to drugs**" as part of the dance step. They have to be creative.
5. Attire may include accessories such as hats, scarves, caps, gloves jewelry, etc. Removing pieces of clothing during the performance is permitted provided that it is not offensive or out of character.
6. Body/face oils or paints/other substances applied to the body or clothing that may affect the clean dry surface of the stage and the safety of fellow competitors are prohibited. Paper confetti is not allowed.
7. Judging of entries shall be based on the following criteria:

JUDGING CRITERIA

The judges will score the crews according to the judging criteria on a 100 point system.

1. **Overall Effect (20%)**
 - Confidence/Showmanship, Intensity and Projection (10%)
 - Entertainment Value/Crowd Appeal (5%)
 - Street Presence/Attire (5%)
2. **Choreography (40%)**
 - Creativity (20%)
 - Difficulty (15%)
 - Formations and Transitions (5%)
3. **Technique Execution/Clarity of Movement (40%)**
 - Placement and Control (10%)
 - Musicality (5%)
 - Group Execution (10%)
 - Synchronization/Timing (10%)
 - Spacing (5%)

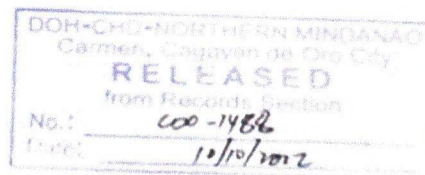

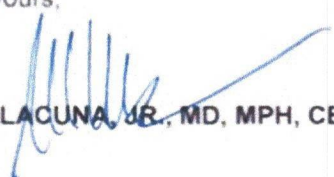

DAPC Week Quiz Bowl Mechanics

1. This contest is by invitation only. **10 participating schools pre-selected by Department of Education – Division of Cagayan de Oro City**. Participating government schools will send only 1 team composed of two (2) bonafide Senior High School Students.
2. The coverage of the quiz bowl are information about:
 - Alcohol and substance abuse
 - RA 9165 "An Act Instituting the Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2022"
 - Community Based Drug Rehabilitation Program
3. The quiz bowl is composed of three rounds: Easy, Average, and Difficult. Each round will have ten (10) questions. Each correct answer to the questions will have the following credit points:
 - Easy Round – 3 points
 - Average Round – 5 points
 - Difficult Round – 10 points
4. Questions will be read twice by the quiz master and will be projected on the screen as well.
5. Teams are given the following time to answer the questions:
 - Easy Round – Fifteen (15) Seconds
 - Average Round – Thirty (30) Seconds
 - Difficult Round – Sixty (60) Seconds
6. Timer starts after the quiz master says GO.
7. Materials needed for the quiz bee will be provided by the DOH CHD-NM.
8. Scores will be added cumulatively, after all three rounds. The team with the highest score wins the Quiz Bowl.
9. The winners will be awarded plaques and corresponding cash prizes.
10. The decision of the panel of arbiters is final.
