About STEM Warriors Club

STEM Warriors is a club for students ages 11-17 who want to explore the STEM world. Members participate in challenges, meet-ups, and field trips while enjoying a supportive community where they can connect with peers and explore their STEM interests.





The Summit will host 90 Grade 8-10 students and 10 teachers, giving them the opportunity to explore STEM careers and innovations. We hope to invite nine (9) public junior high schools, each with **ten (10)** Grade 8-10 student participants accompanied by **one (1)** teacher. We encourage schools to select a diverse group of students, including at least 50% female students, to inspire more women to pursue STEM careers.
