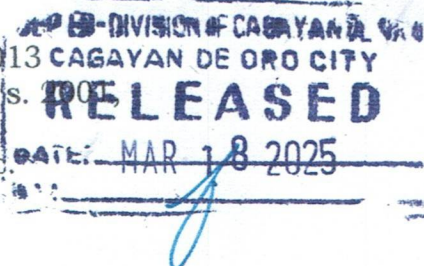

Greetings!

March is Rabies Awareness Month. In line with our campaign to raise awareness against the Rabies virus, the City Veterinary Office will launch a Poster-Making Contest on **March 28, 2025** at **Carmen National High School** from **1:00 o'clock to 5:00 o'clock** in the afternoon. This year's theme is *Rabies-Free na Pusa't Aso, Kaligtasan ng Pamilyang Pilipino*, with a sub-theme: *Rabies Likayan, Binuhing Iro Dili Buy-an, Kada Tuig Bakunahan*.

The mechanics of the contest are as follows:

1. On a first-to-confirm basis, ten (10) District 1 schools and ten (10) District 2 schools will comprise as participants. Each school shall be represented by only one Grade 6 learner as contestant.
2. All contestants will be provided with the same drawing materials each for free, and only the drawing materials provided shall be allowed to be used during the poster making.
3. The duration of the contest is two (2) hours, and an extension of thirty (30) minutes will be given if necessary.

The City Veterinary Office will be giving generous prizes to the winners as well as to the non-winners. The criteria for judging will be announced during the contest proper.
