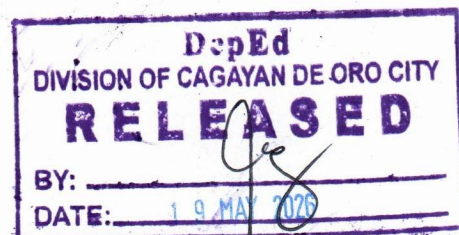

PARTICIPATION IN THE SIMULTANEOUS COASTAL CLEAN-UP DRIVE

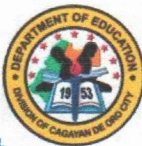
