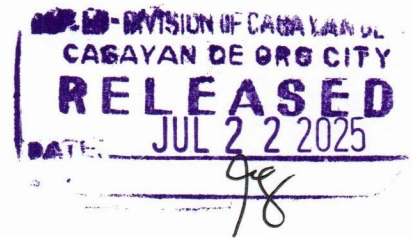

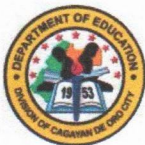

IMPLEMENTATION OF SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM SY 2025-2026

This Division

1. Pursuant to Republic Act No. 11037 otherwise known as "Masustansyang Pagkain para sa Batang Pilipino Act", the School Governance and Operations Division through the School Health and Nutrition Section (SGOD-SHN) shall implement the School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP) by providing Nutritious Food Products (NFP) and Milk component targeting Kindergarten to Grade 6 Severely Wasted (SW) and Wasted (W) beneficiaries.
2. The DO No. 31 s. 2021, DO No. 38 s. 2022, DO No. 10 s. 2022 and DepEd Office Memorandum OM-OUOPS-2025-09-10424, OM-OUOPS-2025-08-00460, OM-OUOPS-2025-08-02500 shall be used until the new issuance of SBFP Guidelines.
3. The program shall be implemented for a feeding period of 120 days for the Nutritious Food Products (NFP) component starting on **July 28, 2025**, and 15 feeding days for the Milk component starting in August/September 2025.
4. The Nutritious Food Product items are as follows:
 - a. Enhanced Nutribun
 - b. Milky Bun
 - c. Fortified / Enriched Bread (Piaya)

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- d. Brown Rice Nutty Fruity Bar
- e. Cookies in combination with Fruit Juice
- f. Nutripacks (Rice Porridge – Champorado)
- g. Biscuit in combination with Nutripacks (Nutri-Oats)
- h. Fruit Juice in combination with Wafer
- i. Iron-Fortified Rice (IFR)
- j. Brown Rice

5. All food items shall be delivered every Monday. In the event of class suspensions, holidays, or other causes of delay, delivery shall be made on the next available class day. All food products must be properly handled and stored at all times. Any case of spoilage or related concerns must be documented and reported immediately to the Division SBFP Focal Persons for appropriate action.

6. Attached is the list of recipient schools along with the corresponding number of allocated beneficiaries for reference.

7. All forms, information, announcements, and memoranda related to School-Based Feeding Program can now be accessed through the SBFP application.

8. In adherence to Equal Opportunity Policy (EOP), inclusive and fair treatment are accorded to all participants regardless of age, gender, sexual orientation, disability, religion, and ethnicity.

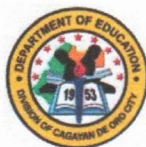
