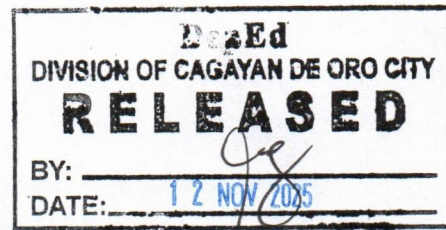

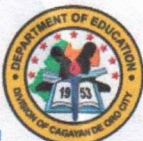

CELEBRATION OF 2025 FILIPINO VALUES MONTH

To: Schools Division Superintendents
All Others Concerned

1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 479, Series of 1994, which declares November of each year as Filipino Values Month, the Department of Education Regional Office 10 urges all Schools Division Offices to encourage schools to organize activities that celebrate and promote positive cultural and moral values essential for social unity, responsible citizenship, and nation-building.
2. The theme for this year, ***"Bagong Pilipinas, Bagong Pag-asa: Pagkakaisa at Pananagutan para sa Makabuluhang Pagbabago"*** highlights the essential role of the youth in driving national progress, urging them to lead with Filipino values and actively shape a more inclusive and transformative future for the Philippines.
3. Aside from value integration in classroom teaching and learning activities, schools and divisions are encouraged to conduct any of the following:
 - a. **Poster and Slogan-Making Contest** – Expressing unity and hope for a "Bagong Pilipinas."
 - b. **Essay Writing Contest** – Reflecting on *pagkakaisa* and *pananagutan* as keys to meaningful change.
 - c. **Values Discussion during Flag Ceremonies** – Weekly short talks on core Filipino values like *bayanihan*, *malasakit*, *disiplina*, and *katapatan*.
 - d. **Values-Based Film Showing and Reflection** – Viewing films that promote empathy, responsibility, and national pride.
 - e. **Youth Leadership Forum or Seminar** – Sharing youth-led initiatives that inspire change in schools or communities.

- f. **Social Media Campaign** – Digital posters, short videos, or reflections using hashtags like **#ValuesMonth2025** and **#BagongPilipinasBagongPagAsa**.
- g. **“Acts of Hope” Project** – Simple class or school projects showing collective responsibility (e.g., clean-up drive, outreach, tree planting).
- h. **“Kwento ng Pagbabago” Storytelling** – Sharing inspiring stories of transformation by learners, teachers, or parents.
- i. **Cultural Performances and Exhibits** – Showcasing songs, dances, and artworks that celebrate Filipino unity and hope.

4. School heads are requested to make the necessary arrangements to ensure compliance with the no-disruption-of-classes policy as outlined in DepEd Order No. 9, Series of 2005, titled *“Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-On-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith.”*

5. All expenses related to the celebration will be charged to the school’s MOOE/local funds, in accordance with existing government accounting and auditing rules and regulations. It is also emphasized that no financial burdens should be imposed on learners or parents.

6. This office directs the immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum.

PROCLAMATION NO. 479

DECLARING THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER OF EVERY YEAR AS FILIPINO
VALUES MONTH

WHEREAS, Proclamation No. 62, dated September 30, 1992, declared a Moral Recovery Program in response to the need to strengthen the moral resources of the Filipino rooted in Filipino culture, values and ideals that are pro-God, pro-people, pro-country, and pro-nature, and thereby mobilizing all Filipinos for nation-building through the practical exercise of human values in our daily lives as citizens and to awaken us all to the power of these values in achieving our individual and national goals;

WHEREAS, the promotion and engendering of a sustained Moral Recovery Program may be further facilitated through a vigorous and coordinated campaign measures actively participated in by all sectors of Filipino society;

WHEREAS, the celebration of Filipino Values Month, on a regular basis is a desirable and effective measure to create moral awakening and national consciousness on human values that are unique, genuine and positively Filipino.

NOW, THEREFOR, I, FIDEL V. RAMOS, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare the month of November of every year as "Filipino Values Month" under the auspices of the Kabisig People Movement. Filipinos of all ages and from all sectors of our society are hereby enjoined to actively participate in the observance thereof.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.

Done in the City of Manila, this 7th day of October, in the year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and ninety-four.
