CONTEST GUIDELINES

The competition is open to teachers and students from **all 14 Schools Division Offices (SDOs) in Region X**.

1. Competition Categories and Themes

All SDOs shall submit their **top three entries per category**. Four categories will be implemented:

- a. **Category 1 – DepEd Employees**
Theme: Kinder to Grade 3 – Reading and Literacy with emphasis on Local Heritage
- b. **Category 2 – DepEd Employees**
Theme: Grades 4–6 – Mathematics in Stories
- c. **Category 3 – Teacher–Student Collaboration**
Theme: Science and Technology
- d. **Category 4 – Student Collaboration**
Theme: Technology

All entries must be original, unpublished, and not AI-generated.

2. Mechanics and Submission Guidelines

- a. Entries must be written in English.
- b. Adaptation of local stories is allowed, provided cultural respect is observed.
- c. AI-generated texts, images, or stock photos are strictly prohibited.
- d. Minimum page requirements apply:
 - i. Kinder–Grade 3: 4–6 text pages
 - ii. Others: At least 20 pages



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- e. Standard front and back matters must be included (Front Cover, Title Page, Copyright Page, About the Author, etc.).
- f. Trim Size: A4; Font: Arial/Sans Serif/Garamond; Spacing: 1.15
- g. Digital and printed copies must be submitted **on or before January 16, 2025**, to DepEd Region X. All entries must have the assignment of rights form in Attachment No. 2.
- h. Copyright of submitted entries will belong to DepEd Region X, with proper author recognition.
- i. Judges' decisions are final and irrevocable.

3. Judging Criteria

- a. Text/Story Content – 40%
- b. Art/Illustrations – 40%
- c. Cultural & Educational Value – 10%
- d. Overall Impact – 10%

I. ACTIVITY TITLE: E-STORYA: STORYBOOK WRITING COMPETITION 2026

A Joint Initiative of the Local Government Unit of Cagayan de Oro City, DepEd - Division of Cagayan de Oro, and DepEd Regional Office X

II. RATIONALE/ BACKGROUND

The Department of Education (DepEd) Region X and the DepEd Division of Cagayan de Oro, in partnership with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Cagayan de Oro City, recognize the vital role of storytelling in strengthening literacy, creativity, and cultural pride among Filipino learners.

Through the **E-STORYA Storybook Writing Competition**, the DepEd - Region X, DepEd Division of CDO, and LGU CDO collaborate to provide a platform for teachers and students to produce storybooks that reflect local values, indigenous traditions, community resilience, and contemporary issues. This joint initiative underscores the importance of public sector collaboration in promoting quality education and preserving cultural heritage. The collected stories will be used to support various reading and literacy programs.

To further enhance accessibility, promote inclusive education, and support the city's digital transformation initiatives, the storybooks developed through this competition will be formally integrated into the official repository of the **DepEd - Division of Cagayan de Oro City E-Library**. This digital inclusion ensures that learners, educators, and community members—regardless of geographic or socio-economic status—have free and open access to high-quality, localized learning materials.

By making these storybooks available online, the project reinforces the city's commitment to technology-enabled learning, fosters a culture of reading, and broadens the reach of culturally relevant educational resources across Cagayan de Oro and the wider Region X. It also contributes to the sustainability of the initiative by ensuring that the outputs are preserved, continually accessible, and effectively utilized to support literacy development, instructional enrichment, and community engagement in both formal and non-formal education settings.

III. RELEVANCE TO THE RISE DEVELOPMENT AGENDA

The E-STORYA Storybook Writing Competition directly supports the RISE Development Agenda of the Local Government of Cagayan de Oro City by contributing to the following key pillars:





R – Resilience: The activity promotes community resilience by encouraging the creation of stories that reflect the lived experiences of local communities, including themes of disaster preparedness, recovery, and adaptation. These narratives help foster awareness, preparedness, and emotional resilience among learners.

I – Innovation: By integrating creative writing and digital publication, the competition drives educational innovation. It empowers teachers and students to use storytelling as a medium for expressing ideas, addressing societal issues, and developing 21st-century skills such as communication, critical thinking, and creativity.

S – Sustainability: The project emphasizes environmental awareness, indigenous knowledge systems, and the preservation of local culture. It encourages sustainable practices by embedding themes of environmental stewardship and cultural continuity in story content, ensuring relevance to the ecological and cultural contexts of the region.

E – Empowerment: E-STORYA creates inclusive opportunities for both learners and educators to voice their narratives. By recognizing diverse perspectives—including those of women, indigenous peoples, and marginalized communities—it supports inclusive education and gender-sensitive development. The competition uplifts local talents and strengthens civic pride, identity, and agency.

In alignment with the RISE Agenda, this initiative demonstrates a strong commitment to nurturing future-ready citizens, enhancing educational quality, and sustaining local heritage through collaborative governance and creative expression.

IV. OBJECTIVES OF THE ACTIVITY

1. To encourage teachers and students to create original and creative storybooks that foster literacy, innovation, and critical thinking.
2. To showcase collaborative efforts of the LGU and DepEd Division and Region X in advancing educational excellence and cultural identity.
3. To integrate cross-cutting themes such as Gender and Development, Disaster Risk Reduction, Environmental Sustainability, and Indigenous Knowledge.
4. To reward and recognize outstanding works that will become part of DepEd's Region X and Division's pool of localized learning resources.
5. To publish selected winning and non-winning entries under the joint name of DepEd Region X, DepEd Division of Cagayan de Oro and LGU Cagayan de Oro City, with copyright belonging to DepEd Region X and the Division office.

A. Methods:

1. Themes:	"E-STORYA: Empowering Stories for Young Readers and Artists"
2. Mechanics:	The competition is open to teachers and students from public schools in Cagayan de Oro and across Region X. A minimum of 11 entries shall come from SDO-CTDO, and at least 3 entries from each of the remaining 13 SDOs in the region, to gather a total of at least 50 entries per category.
3. Categories	a. Entries shall be classified into four (4) categories: ● Category 1: DepEd Employees – both the writer and illustrator must be DepEd employees. <i>Theme:</i> Kinder to Grade 3 – Reading and Literacy with emphasis on local heritage. ● Category 2: DepEd Employees – both the writer and illustrator must be DepEd employees. <i>Theme:</i> Grades 4 to 6 – Mathematics in Stories. ● Category 3: Collaborative Teacher-Student – one (1) student and one (1) DepEd employee, either as writer or illustrator. <i>Theme:</i> Science and Technology. ● Category 4: Student Collaboration – both the writer and illustrator must be students from the basic education levels (Kinder to Senior High School). <i>Theme:</i> Technology. b. Stories must be in English. c. Each entry must be original, unpublished, and not previously submitted in other competitions. d. Adaptation and unique retelling of local stories may be done with respect and consideration of indigenous and local traditions. e. Each entry must be original, unpublished, and not previously submitted in other competitions. f. Adaptation and unique retelling of local stories may be done with respect and consideration of indigenous and local traditions. g. AI-generated texts, illustrations, internet images, stock photos, and non-original art are not allowed.

Works must not contain plagiarized, AI-generated, or stock content. d. Text Pages – Each entry must contain the following minimum number of actual text pages (exclusive of front and back matters): • Category 1 (DepEd Employees): Kinder - Grade 3: At least 4 - 6 pages • Category 2 (DepEd Employees): Grade 4 - Grade 6: At least 20 pages • Category 3 (Teacher - Student Collaboration): At least 20 pages • Category 3 (Student Collaboration): At least 20 pages e.
