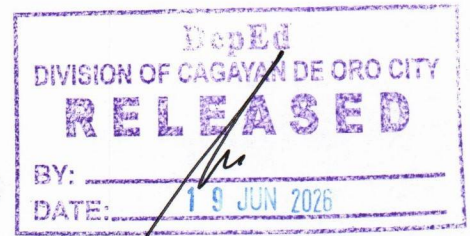

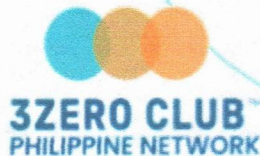

We sincerely hope that this upcoming convention will serve as the beginning of a lasting partnership between our organizations in advancing more programs that empower youth.

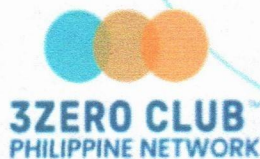

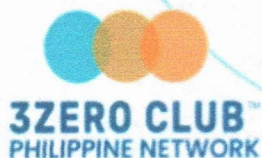
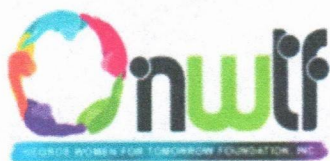
