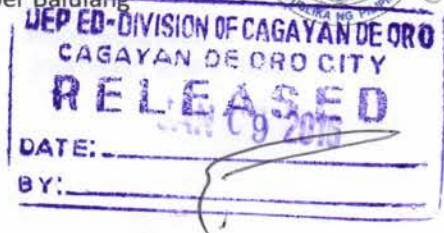

1. In preparation for participation to the 2017 National Schools Press Conference (NSPC) in Pagadian City on January 22-25, 2017, this Office through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) will conduct an Enhancement Training for all Region X NSPC qualifiers on **January 20-21, 2017** at Ozamiz City National High School (OCNHS), Division of Ozamiz City.
2. Participants to this activity are the identified **286 official delegates** to the 2017 NSPC per Regional Memorandum No 5, s. 2017. Division coordinators who wish to join the enhancement training and the NSPC but not included in the official list are advised to seek Travel Authority from the SDS. Non-attendance of the official delegates to this activity means no participation to the 2017 NSPC.
3. All participants are expected to arrive in the morning of January 19, 2017. Likewise, participants are advised to bring plain white T-shirt with collar; without collar for journalists to be printed by SHS in Ozamiz City.
4. All coaches are required to bring **copies of the school publication** for their contestants, journalism training plans, attested by the school head, affirmed by the Division journalism coordinator and noted by the Schools Division Superintendent. Campus journalists are also required to bring their portfolio in journalism.
5. Accommodation will be at OCNHS, Ozamiz City. Meals of participants for 2 days, payments of vest, t-shirt printing, and other expenses relative to preparation for NSPC participation shall be charged to DepEd subsidy for 2016 regional training in journalism while transportation and other expenses of participants shall be charged against school MOOE or any available local/journalism funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.
