

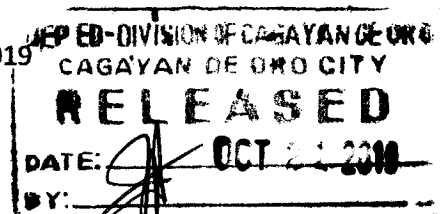

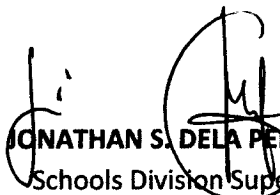

Participants will only shoulder their Registration of P800 each.

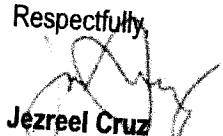
