

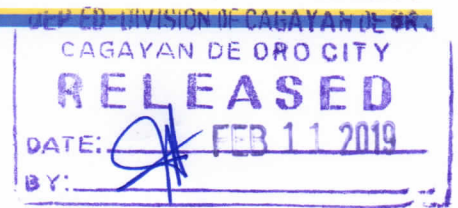

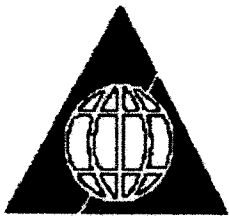
PRE-EMPLOYMENT ORIENTATION SEMINAR (PEOS)

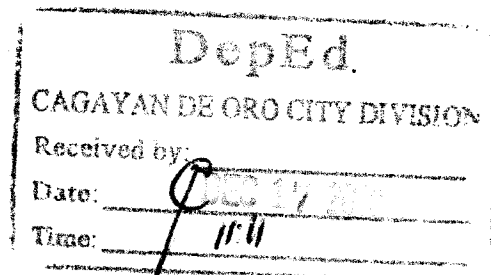
