

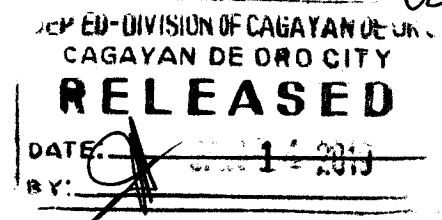

 - Abstract (at most 300 words)
 - Full paper (15-20 pages with references)
 - The paper should be: single-spaced, Arial, size 12; MS Word format
 - Contents of the presentation: Title, Brief Background/Introduction, Objectives/Problems, Methodology, Summary of Findings, Conclusions, Recommendations, and Bibliography
- Time allotted for presentation: 20 minutes (Powerpoint Delivery) and 10 minutes (Open Forum)
- The best presenter shall be awarded certificate of recognition based on the following criteria:

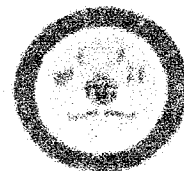
Please be informed that accepted manuscript will be further edited and that the Research Forum organizer reserves the right to publish the paper in the peer-reviewed Career and Employment Journal.

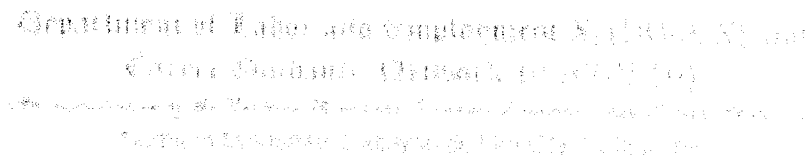
