The training aims to revolutionize the idea of leadership by focusing on the importance of having a leader's heart as an educator and to be aware of relevant issues in the country which affect our student's education.

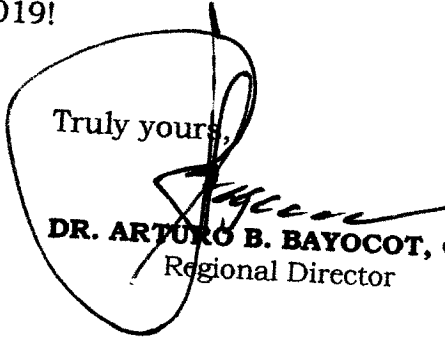
