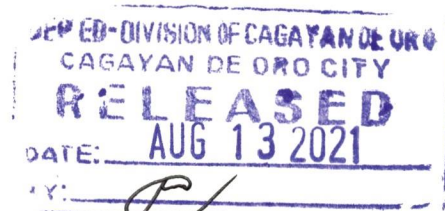

1. In reference to Regional Memorandum No. 424, s. 2021, the Department of Education Region X, in coordination with South East Asian Ministers of Education Organization for Educational Innovation and Technology (SEAMEO - INNOTECH), promotes the professional development and advancement of teachers, school heads, and other personnel in the Region. Being an accredited service provider of the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) the SEAMEO offered several courses, to wit:
 - a. **TEACHexCELS** (Teaching Learning Excellence in School Leadership for South East Asia) designed to build the capacity of school heads to develop and strengthen the management of teaching and learning process in school. Course fee is Ten Thousand pesos (Php 10,000.00) per participant;
 - b. **SUPERexCELS** or Supervision Excellence in School Leadership for Southeast Asia is designed for supervisors and school heads. It addresses the need to develop and strengthen their capacity for developmental, differentiated, and clinical supervision. Course fee is Fifteen Thousand pesos (Php 16,000.00) per participants;

- c. **Guro 21 Course 1** or Gearing up Responsible & Outstanding Teachers in Southeast Asia for the 21st Century entitled “ Facilitating the Development of 21st Century Skills for Southeast Asian Teachers” . This is designed to build the capacity of teachers in facilitating the development of the 21st century skills. GURO21 Course 1 fee is Six thousand pesos (Php 6,000.00) per participant;
 - d. **Guro 21 Course 2** or Gearing up Responsible & Outstanding Teachers in Southeast Asia for the 21st Century entitled “ Developing Higher Order Thinking Skills (HOTS). This is designed to build the capacity of teachers to develop higher order thinking skills. GURO21 Course 2 fee is Six thousand pesos (Php 6,000.00) per participant;
 - e. **PEACEeXCELS** Peace Education Excellence in Emergency Situations for Southeast Asian School Heads. This is designed to develop and promote a culture of peace and respect for cultural diversity. The course fee of this program is Ten Thousand Pesos (10,000.00)
 - f. **HEALTHeXCELS** Health Management Excellence for Southeast Asian School Heads. This is designed to champion health and improve the school environment by effectively managing and implementing school based health programs. Course fee is Ten Thousand (Php 10,000.00) per participant.
 - g. **STI** Strategic Thinking & Innovation. The course dwells on the competency, concepts, related to it, and its values as a success competency for Southeast Asian School Heads. The course fee is Ten Thousand (Php 10,000.00) per participant.
2. The nominees are required to register online via the link provided (please see attached copy).
 3. Deadline of submission of names will be on August 17, 2021 to Human Resource Division, SGOD Office.
 4. Course fees (which include the orientation and revalida fees, travel and other incidental expenses during the Orientation and Revalida shall be charged to local funds, subject to accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

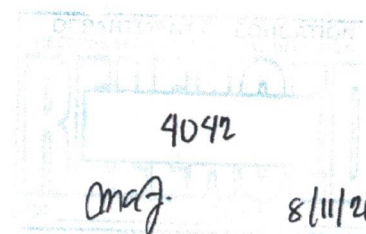
