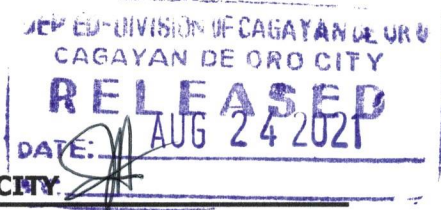

MALUNGGAY/MORINGA TREES IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

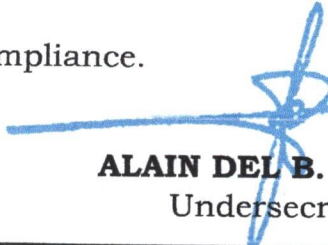
