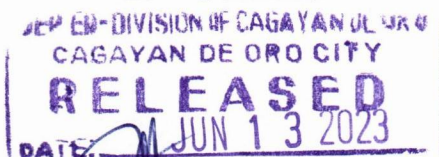

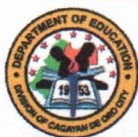

SUBMISSION OF LIST OF TAKERS FOR THE
2023 NATIONAL ACHIEVEMENT TEST FOR GRADE 10 (NAT G10)

TO: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
Chief Education Supervisor - CID
Chief Education Supervisor – SGOD
School Heads, Public Secondary and Integrated Schools
School Heads, Private Secondary Schools

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memo No. 34 s.2023, the **National Achievement Test for Grade 10 (NATG10)** shall be conducted on **June 27, 2023** to all public and private schools offering Grade 10.
2. The NATG10 will be administered to sampled Grade 10 learners in all regional offices (ROs), schools division offices (SDOs), and schools offering the Grade 10 curriculum in public and private schools through a paper-based modality.
3. The sampling procedure and format in selecting Grade 10 learners per school is explained in the attached power point presentation for reference and guidance. Schools shall submit the final list of takers (excel file, format is indicated in the ppt reference) based on the sample size assigned to their school on or before **June 16, 2023**. The **official school email (private schools)/ deped email (public schools) of the school head** shall be used in sending the official list in **MS Excel file** to **eleanorconsejo.rollan@deped.gov.ph**
4. Participating schools are also reminded to prepare the testing centers based on the number of sampled takers and the guidelines prescribed by the Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA). Comprehensive orientation of all school testing personnel and the sampled takers shall be conducted by the school head.
5. Student orientation and other preparations shall be undertaken by the school to ensure successful implementation of the said national assessment.
6. References on the test administration to be used for the orientation of school testing personnel can be downloaded from bit.ly/2023NATG10
7. In adherence to Equal Opportunity Policy (EOP), inclusive and fair treatment are accorded to all concerned regardless of age, gender, sexual orientation, disability, religion and ethnicity.

**ADMINISTRATION OF THE NATIONAL ACHIEVEMENT TEST FOR GRADE 10 FOR
SCHOOL YEAR 2022-2023**

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) will administer the **National Achievement Test for Grade 10 (NATG10)** for School Year (SY) 2022-2023 on **June 27, 2023**, pursuant to DepEd Order (DO) No. 55, s. 2016 titled **Policy Guidelines on the National Assessment of Student Learning for the K to 12 Basic Education Program** and DO 34, s. 2022 titled **School Calendar and Activities for the SY 2022-2023**.
2. The NATG10 will be administered to sampled Grade 10 learners in all regional offices (ROs), schools division offices (SDOs), and schools offering the Grade 10 curriculum in public and private schools through a paper-based modality.
3. The NATG10 is one of the exit assessments under the national assessment framework of the K to 12 Basic Education Program. It is designed to determine if Grade 10 learners are meeting the learning standards of the Junior High School (JHS) curriculum.
4. In reference to DO 29, s. 2022 titled Adoption of the Basic Education Monitoring and Evaluation Framework, DepEd has to identify and articulate performance indicators and outcomes for measuring performance in the development of plans and policies. These indicators and outcomes will be used for the assessment of the effectiveness and efficiency of the delivery of education services. The results of system assessments will serve as evidence for the improvement of the curriculum implementation.
5. The test shall cover **21st Century Skills (Problem Solving, Information Literacy, and Critical Thinking)** using learning areas in English, Mathematics, Science, Filipino, and Araling Panlipunan as content. The test design is progressive in nature wherein test items measure varying levels of skills in a multiple-choice format using English and Filipino language.
6. The Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA) will manage the national implementation of the NATG10 with the assistance of the ROs and SDOs. BEA will coordinate with the identified field-testing personnel for the conduct of the national conference and administration of the NATG10.

7. The guidelines on the test administration, including the roles and responsibilities of the field-testing personnel and the downloading of the Program Support Funds (PSF) to SDOs will be discussed in a virtual orientation that will be held on **June 7, 2023, 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.** The link of the virtual orientation will be sent to the regional testing coordinators (RTCs), division testing coordinators (DTCs), and SDO Private School Supervisors through an advisory.
8. Moreover, the sampling procedure in selecting Grade 10 learners per school will be discussed during the virtual orientation.
9. Health and safety protocols must be followed in all activities to be done in relation to the national test administration.

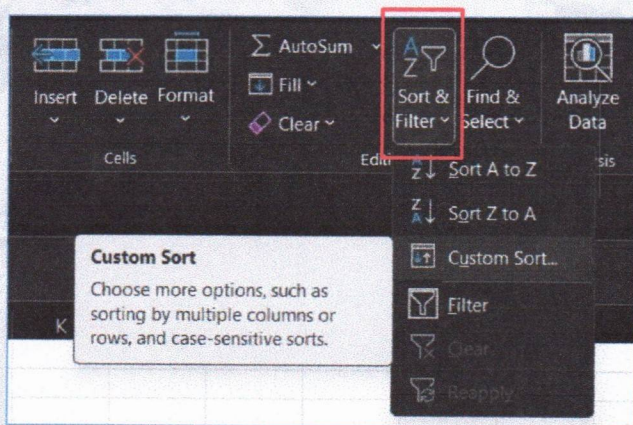

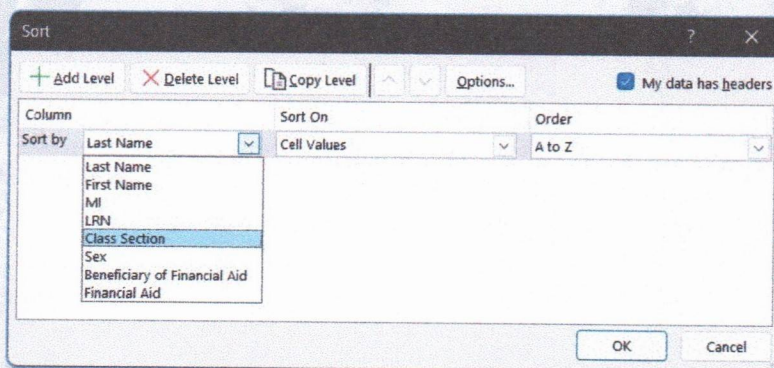

- The **Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA)** has already prepared and distributed **Annex A** to the **Regional Testing Coordinators (RTCs)**.
- **Annex A** shall be forwarded by the **RTCs** to the **DTCs**.
- The **Division Testing Coordinators (DTCs)** shall refer to **Annex A** for the **Allocation** of Grade 10 learners who will take the NAT G10 at each school.
- The **School Heads (SHs) / School Testing Coordinators (STCs)** shall be responsible for the selection guidelines on the NAT G10 Allocation.

Step 13

Compute the **sampling interval** using the formula below:

$$k = \llbracket N/n \rrbracket$$

where N = total number of Grade 10 learners in the school

n = **Allocation** of Grade 10 learners in the school (based on **Annex A**)

Note that $\llbracket \rrbracket$ is the greatest integer function that simply disregards the decimal number of the computed value.

For example,

- If $N/n = 9.1$, then $k = 9$
- If $N/n = 3.8$, then $k = 3$



Example

Suppose the **Allocation** of Grade 10 learners in the school is $n = 56$ and the total number of Grade 10 learners in the school is $N = 200$.

Calculate the **sampling interval** using the formula below:

$$k = \llbracket N/n \rrbracket$$

For this example,

total number of Grade 10 learners in the school

Allocation of Grade 10 learners in the school (based on **Annex A**)

$$k = \llbracket 200/56 \rrbracket$$

$$k = \llbracket 3.57 \rrbracket$$

$$k = 3$$

Computed value of the **sampling interval** based on the formula given

The **sampling interval** after disregarding the decimal number of the computed value



Step 14

Once the **k** is obtained, it will represent the **sampling interval** in choosing the learners who will take the test.

In the list, the **SH/STC** may randomly start choosing from 1 to **k** . The random start (**r**) means the first learner in the sample.

Example

The sampling interval is **$k = 3$** . To obtain the first examinee in the sample, we need to choose a number randomly from **1 to $k = 3$** . For instance, we choose the random start **$r = 2$** . This means that the first examinee is the second learner in the list. In the example, **Agustin, Billie Y.** is the first examinee.

Once the **SH/STC** reaches the designated **Allocation**, a list of sampled learners shall be prepared, containing the following information:

- Learner's **Last name, First Name, and Middle Initial**
- **Learner's Reference Number (LRN)**
- **Class Section**
- **Sex** whether **Male** or **Female**
- **Beneficiary of Financial Aid** whether **Yes** or **No**
- If **Yes**, **Financial Aid** whether **4Ps** (for **Public Schools**); or **EVS** or **ESC** (for **Private Schools**)

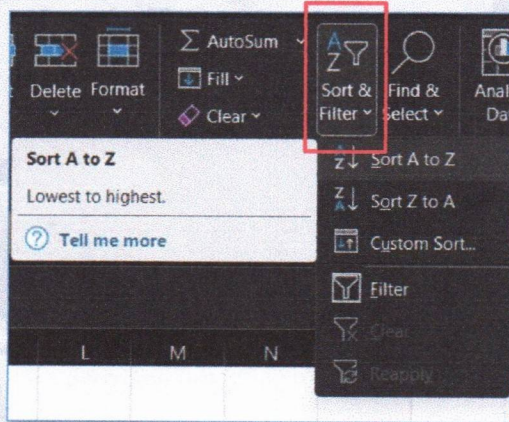
