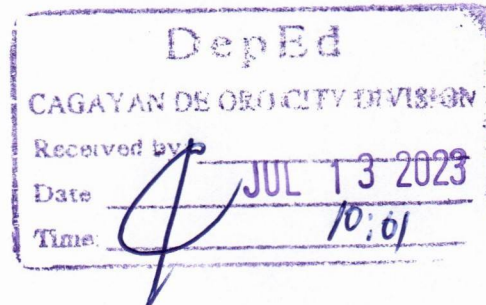

We will be giving subsidies to the first 10 registered participating contingents and winning teams will receive the following prizes:

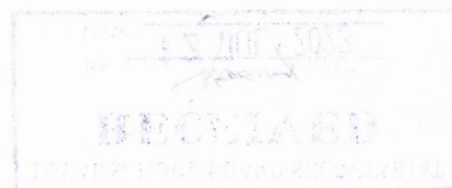
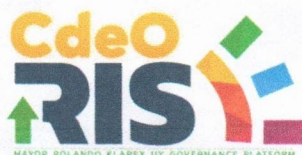
- Champion - 75,000 cash prize

P.E. RHYTHMIC DANCE COMPETITION 2023

Rationale:

The City of Cagayan de Oro will soon celebrate its annual fiesta the coming August. In this regard, the city wants to ensure that the festivities that will be held for this year can bring back the joy and marvel that every Kagay-anon deserves.

As part of the 2023 City Fiesta Activities, the city is planning to hold a competition for field demonstration among public and private elementary learners. This **P.E Rhythmic Dance Competition** has become one of the highlights of the Annual Fiesta Celebration in the previous years before the pandemic.

I. MECHANICS and GUIDELINES

1. Each School from Elementary both Public school and Private school must have one entry with a minimum of four hundred fifty (450) and a maximum of five hundred (500) members.
2. During the dance contest, each contingent must wear their school P.E uniform if available/ modified costume of their choice.
3. The minimum length of the performance is Seven (7) minutes and a maximum of Ten (10)minutes. Contingent who go beyond or fall short based on the time provided will be penalized. Every exceeding second will get a one (1) point deduction from the total score.
4. Each group will be given one minute to prepare before the start of the routine and another one minute to leave the performance ground. Exit time will continue to run as long as there are performers/ dancers and/or props left in the performance ground. Violation of the entrance and exit time will be penalized. Every exceeding second will get a one (1) point deduction from the total score. Time will start on the first note of the music.
5. Participants' music must be submitted one day before the Competition. It must be in a flash drive bearing the school names.
6. Each contingent will perform Rhythmic pattern dance steps with the combination of any kind of dance (hip-hop/Modern choreography)
7. No vulgarity, obscenity, or explicit content is allowed.
8. Props that are not considered an integral part of a group's attire are prohibited (ex. canes, chairs, tambourines, musical instruments).

9. Removing pieces of clothing during the performance is prohibited.
10. Pyrotechnics is absolutely prohibited before, during, or after the performance.
11. No stunts and tosses shall be allowed.
12. Body/face oils or paints/other substances applied to the body or clothing that may affect the clean dry surface of the ground and the safety of fellow contingents are prohibited.
13. The dance showdown/presentation will be judged according to the following criteria.
14. There will be three winners of the contest: Champion, 1st Runner-up, and 2nd Runner-up. Winners will receive a certificate of recognition, a trophy/ Plaque, and a cash prize.
15. Judges' decision is final and irrevocable

II. CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

1. Choreography (Creativity, Variety of floor patterns, Dance Styles & Difficulty) - 40%
 2. Performance (Musicality, Group Execution, Synchronization & Spacing) - 30%
 3. Overall Effect (Showmanship, Intensity, Projection) - 20%
 4. Props and costume/attire - 10%
- TOTAL: 100%

III. SCHEDULE OF ACTIVITY

1. The Rhythmic Dance Competition will be held on August 25, 2023, at 8:00 o'clock in the morning at Don Gregorio Pelaez Sports Complex.
2. Deadline for submission of entry will be on July 21, 2023.
3. Preparation for the said activity shall be done during the school break before the start of the opening of classes along with the Reading Camp Week and Brigada Eskwela Week.
4. Drawing of lots for the order of presentation will be done on August 24, 2023. The number drawn by each Contingent will determine the order of the showdown. Call time for Contingent will be one (1) hour before the start of the contest. Assembly area will be the bleachers at left side facing the grandstand. Late participants will be deducted 5 points from the total score.
5. Final blocking shall be done on August 24, 2023 at 4:00 PM at Don Gregorio Pelaez Sports Complex.
6. Final showdown shall be on August 25, 2023 at 8:00 AM at Don Gregorio Pelaez Sports Complex.
7. Deadline for the submission of Registration Form shall be on or before **July 21, 2023.**

ALL participating schools shall receive a cash assistance of 30,000 pesos each
