The City of Cagayan de Oro through the City Health Office is exerting efforts to detect all kinds of diseases that may occur and compromise the individual's health through our Disease Surveillance in accordance with the Sanitation Code of the Philippines and Notifiable Disease Law (P.D. 856 and its implementing Rules and Regulations, RA 11332 and the City Codified Ordinance of 1994 and its amendments).

2. To ensure close monitoring of diseases, all school principals, DRRM coordinators, and division health personnel are directed to report any abnormal increase of occurrence of the following symptoms to the nearest barangay health center where your campus is situated.

- High Fever
- Cough and colds
- Nausea & vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Myalgia (muscle pain)
- Severe headache
- Sore Throat
- Difficulty Breathing

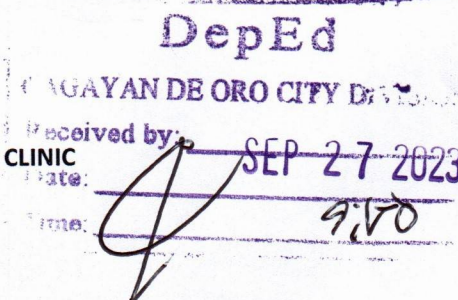

In addition, we also humbly ask for your assistance in the dissemination of this advisory among Public and Private schools under your supervision.

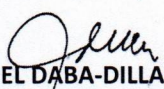
