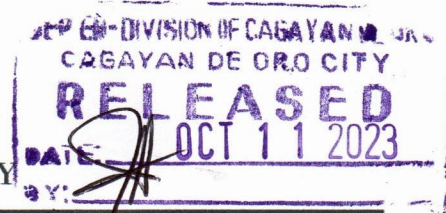

3. This Office directs the immediate compliance of this Memorandum.

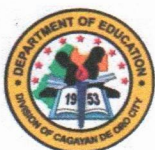
