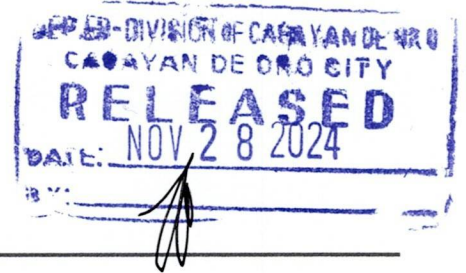

INVITATION TO SAFERKIDSPH ONLINE SEXUAL ABUSE AND EXPLOITATION OF
CHILDREN (OSAEC) TRAINING E-COURSE

SaferKidsPH developed the e-course “OSAEC Awareness Training,” a series of self-paced modules for children, adolescents, parents, and adults working with children. It is designed to raise awareness about the potential dangers children may encounter online, provide practical tools and strategies to help keep them safe, and guide them on how to report abuse and exploitation to the proper authorities.

Interested public and private schools are invited to participate on a voluntary basis.

Participation of public and private schools shall be subject to the non-disruption-of-classes policy stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s.2005 entitled, “Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith.”

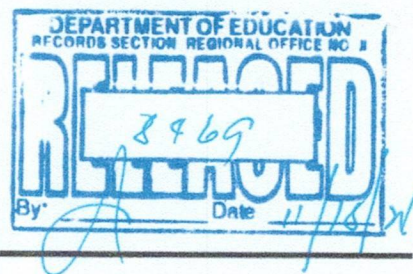

Save the Children Philippines, along with UNICEF, The Asia Foundation, and the Australian Embassy, formed **SaferKidsPH**, a pioneering consortium created to reduce cases of online sexual abuse and exploitation of children (OSAEC) in the Philippines. SaferKidsPH works with children and their families, the Philippine government, civil society and the private sector to ensure that children are safe and protected online.

The number of students from our partner schools and communities who have shared their experiences of online harm is alarming. In response, SaferKidsPH developed the e-course "**OSAEC Awareness Training**," a series of self-paced modules for children, adolescents, parents, and adults working with children. This e-course is designed to raise awareness about the potential dangers children may encounter online, provide practical tools and strategies to help keep them safe, and guide them on how to report abuse and exploitation to the proper authorities. The rising incidents of OSAEC highlight the necessity of this e-course.

Students and teachers from several of our partner schools have already taken this e-course, and the feedback has been highly positive.
