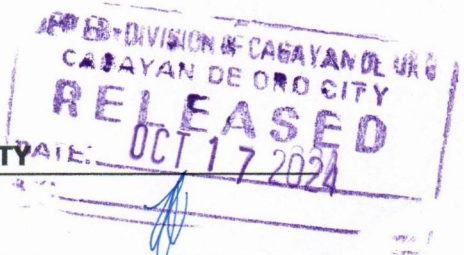

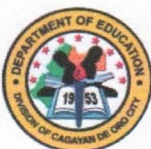

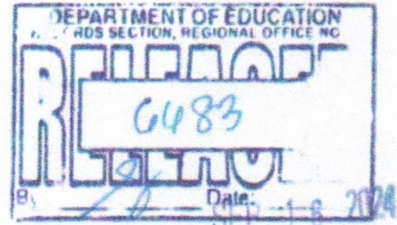

Following **DepEd Order 62, s. 2024** titled **National Indigenous Peoples (IP) Education Policy Framework**, this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), will spearhead the **IP Month Celebration and IPED Summit at Villa Pablea Mountain Resort, Misamis Occidental, on October 22-23**.
2. The activity aims to
 - a. strengthen the partnership between DepEd and the Indigenous Peoples (IP) Communities as a fundamental prerequisite to actualize the inclusion of Indigenous Knowledge System and Practices in the curriculum and meaningful participation of IP communities in the program management and governance, and
 - b. highlight the best practices and success stories in implementing the IPED Program.
3. The participants in this activity are the Schools Division Superintendents and Division IPED Focal Person, and IP Elders of the ICC.
4. There will be a pre-work on October 21 (Monday) for the program management team, with dinner as the first meal. There will be a ritual on Day 1 (October 22). Afternoon snacks will be the last meal on Day 2 (October 23).
