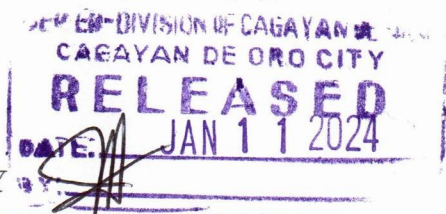

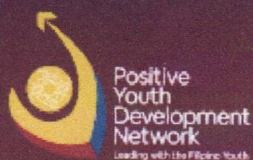

Greetings from the Positive Youth Development Network (PYDN)!

Positive Youth Development Network has an existing partnership with UNICEF Philippines that aims to build a better Philippines through responsive youth and children engagement. Valenzuela City, Angeles City, and now also Cagayan de Oro City have been working with us hand and hand to make sure every child is heard, protected, and empowered of their rights. Recognizing the transition from the pandemic and the rise in cases of Online Sexual Abuse and Exploitation of Children (OSAEC) we are expanding it to the lens of education on how we can teach Digital Responsibility to children and adolescents with also the help of teachers and adults with the Young Heroes Initiative - DigiChamps program.

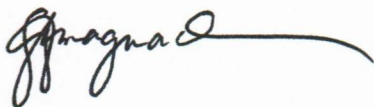

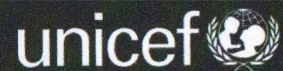

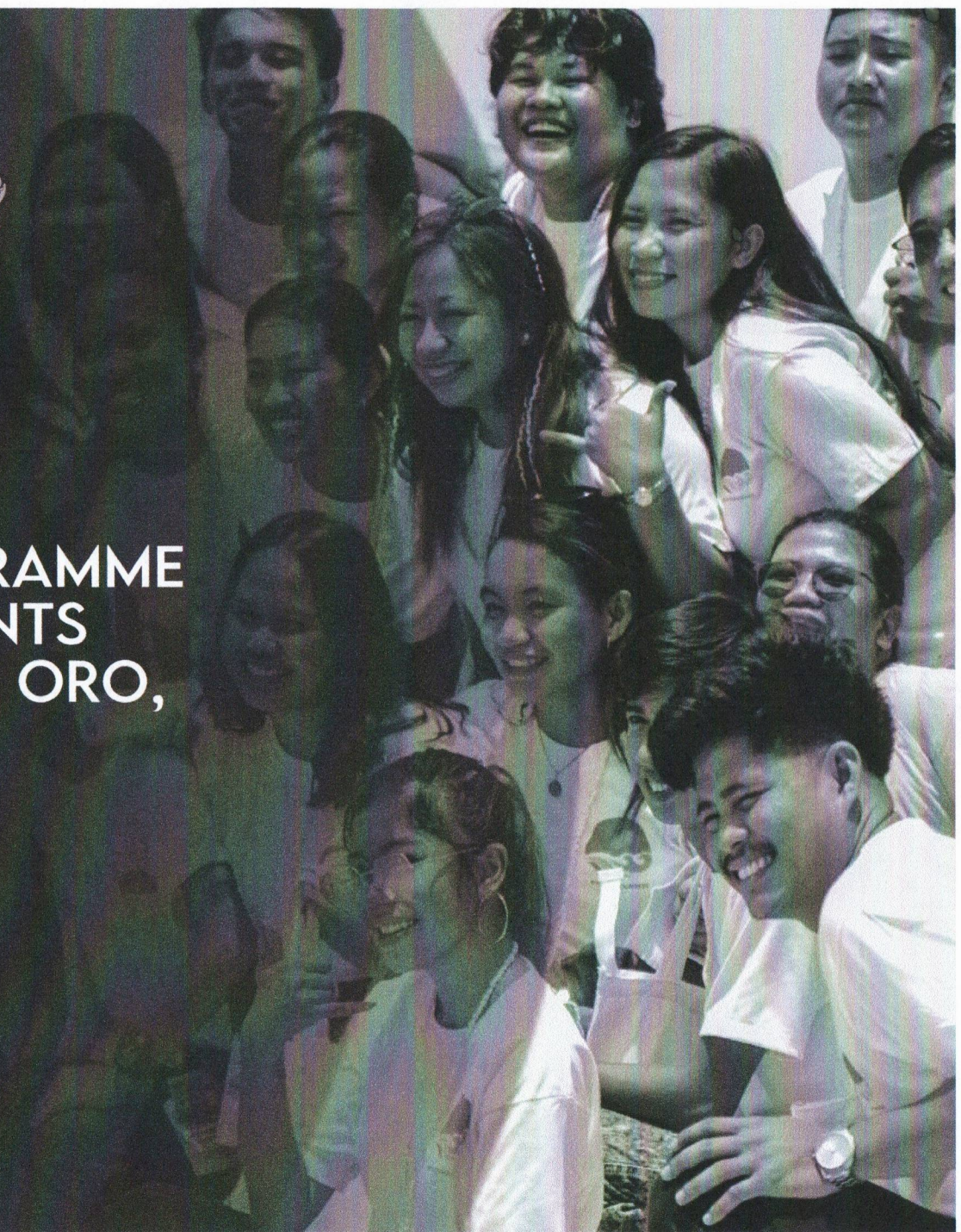

Rationale | Why Digital Responsibility?



Based on the national study on Online Sexual Abuse and Exploitation of Children in the Philippines, the country has emerged as the center of child sexual abuse materials production in the world, with 80% of Filipino children vulnerable to online sexual abuse, some facilitated even by their own peers (UNICEF, 2016).



While slowly the Philippines is already reverting back to normal programs and children and adolescents can already go back to schools and activities, the aftermath of the online setup remain. As part of the new normal, the internet has already been a staple to be able to fully participate in education and learning settings.



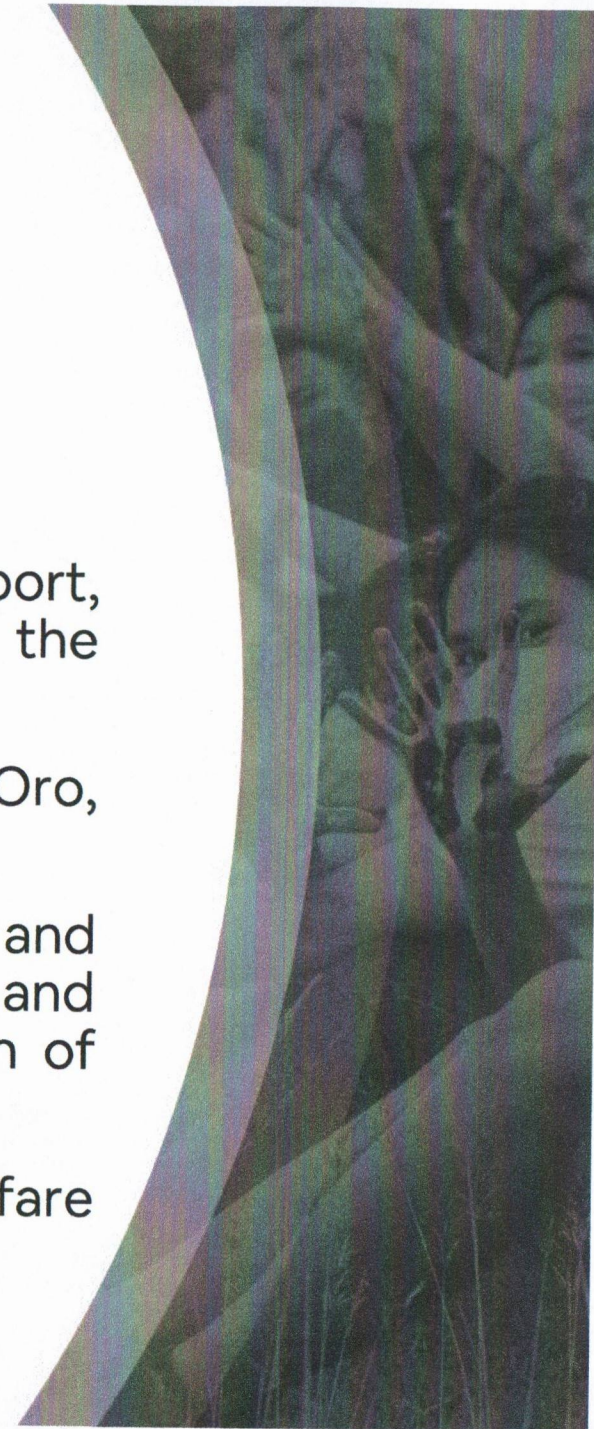

- Relevant partners for the programme (Council for the Welfare of Children, Department of Education, Globe, etc.)



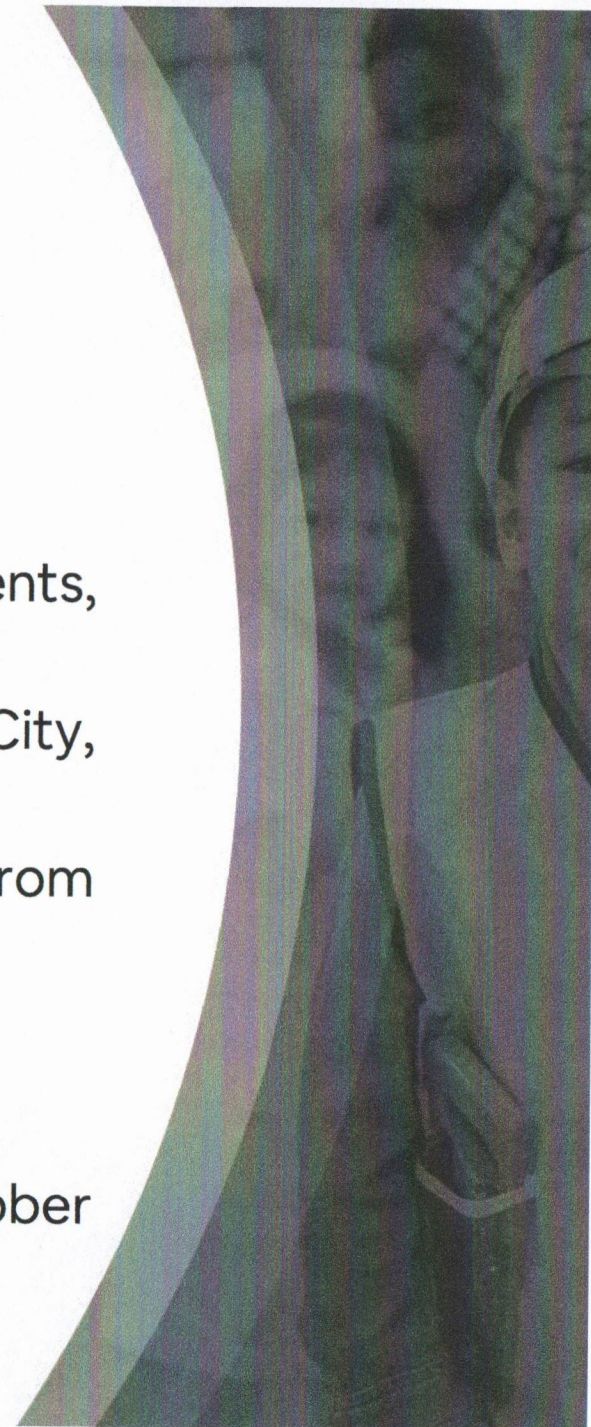
Digital Responsibility Training and Co-creation | Children and Adolescents Champions

September – October 2023

Prior to co-creating the design with children and adolescents, capacity building sessions will be done.

- Joint training with children and adolescents from Angeles City, and Valenzuela City (15 per site).
- Training with fifteen (15) children and adolescents from Cagayan de Oro.

Target Date for Angeles and Valenzuela is September 29-October 1, 2023 to be held at Angeles.



Digital Responsibility Training and Co-creation Workshop | Teachers and Educators

October 2023

In order to get insights from teachers and educators, a capacity building session will be done followed by a co-creation workshop.

- Joint training and co-creation with teachers and educators from Angeles City, and Valenzuela City (30 per site).
- Training and co-creation with thirty (30) teachers and educators from Cagayan de Oro.
