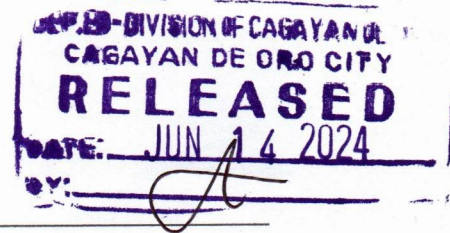

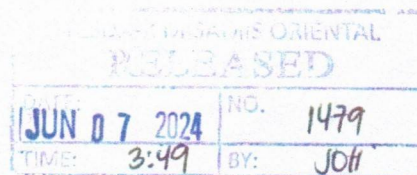

This is in reference to **Joint Memorandum Circular between Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) and Department of Education (DepEd) on Ensuring Quality-Assured Assessment for Certification of Senior High School Technical-Vocational Livelihood Track**, that emphasizes the inclusion in the FY 2024 General Appropriations Act (Republic Act No. 11975) Special Provisions on Senior High School Assessment and Certification Support Program.

Further, this Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) is intended to establish a collaborative framework in the implementation of the said Special Provisions and institutionalize the mandatory assessment for certification of SHS TVL track graduates specifically this SY 2023-2024 to be conducted starting on July 2024 which requires list of candidates (i.e. SHS TVL Track graduates) from your office.

We also would appreciate if such list will be completed on or before **June 13, 2024** to facilitate the scheduling of assessment considering that the process will only cover 10 candidates per assessment.
