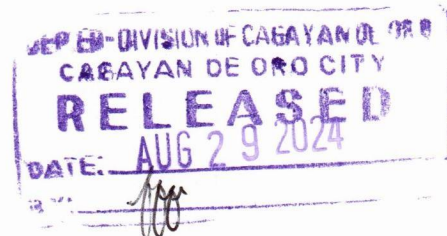

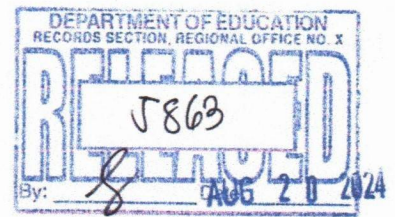

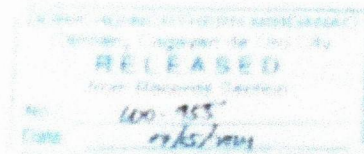

Dear Dr. Bayocot:

The Republic Act 11332 or the Mandatory Reporting of Notifiable Diseases and Health Events of Public Concern Act is a law that provides policies and prescribing procedures on surveillance and response to notifiable diseases, epidemics, and health events of public health concern. The act aims to protect the people from public health threats through the efficient and effective disease surveillance of notifiable diseases. Indicated under Section 6.6 in the IRR, are the list of persons and entities required to comply with the mandatory reporting, that includes public and private educational institutions providing basic education, higher education, or technical-vocational education and/or training.

In response to this, we had conducted a coordination meeting with your office last April 26, 2024 to discuss the proposed methodology of reporting of notifiable diseases among schools and universities as well as identification of pilot sites for the implementation of school based surveillance. As discussed also during the meeting, is the conduct of a disease surveillance training that will capacitate our school doctors and nurses in detecting and reporting notifiable diseases.

We would therefore like to invite at least twenty six (26) participants, with at least one (1) to two (2) representative from each of the fourteen (14) Divisions of Northern Mindanao, to join the **Philippine Integrated Disease Surveillance Response - Epidemic Prone Disease Case Surveillance (PIDSR - EDCS) Orientation and Workshop among Pilot Schools and Universities for School Based Surveillance** this coming **September 2-6, 2024** at **Pearlmount Hotel, Cagayan de Oro City**. This training will equip our pilot schools with the necessary background and knowledge on disease surveillance processes.
