

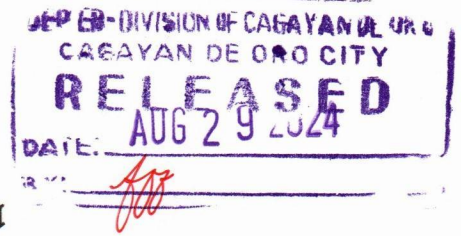

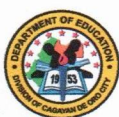
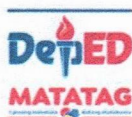

World Teachers' Day Short Film Festival

Theme: "Empowering Educators: Strengthening Resilience, Building Sustainability"

Deadline of Submission: September 16, 2024 – 5:00 PM

Mechanics:

1. Eligibility:

- Each district can submit one short film.
- The film must be created by SSLG (Supreme Secondary Leader Government) officers.
- Films must adhere to the theme "Empowering Educators: Strengthening Resilience, Building Sustainability".

2. Film Specifications:

- Duration: Maximum of 3 minutes, including credits.
- Language: The film may be in any language or dialect, but non-Filipino dialogue must have Filipino subtitles.
- Format: Films should be submitted in MP4 or MOV format.

3. Content Guidelines:

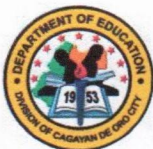
- The film should creatively depict the significant role of teachers in transforming education.
- Content must be original and should not infringe on any copyright or intellectual property.
- Films should be suitable for all audiences, avoiding any offensive language, violence, or inappropriate themes.

4. Submission Process:

- Deadline: All films must be submitted on or before September 16, 2024, at 5:00 PM.
- Submission Method: Films should be uploaded to a designated online platform (Google Drive, Dropbox, etc.), and the link should be emailed to jairusjohn.gochuco@deped.gov.ph.
- File Naming: Each submission should be named as follows: [District Name]_[Film Title].

5. Judging Process:

- A panel of judges will review all submissions prior to the WTD event on September 30.
- It will be posted via DepEd Tayo Page.
- The top films will be selected for presentation on September 30, 2024.

Judging Criteria:

1. Relevance to Theme (30%):

- How well the film captures the theme of "The Transformation of Education Begins with the Teachers."

2. Creativity and Originality (25%):

- The uniqueness of the concept and creativity in storytelling.

3. Technical Quality (20%):

- Quality of production, including cinematography, editing, and sound.

4. Emotional Impact (15%):

- The ability of the film to evoke emotions and connect with the audience.

5. Overall Presentation (10%):

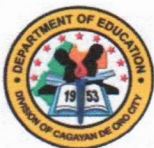
- The coherence and overall polish of the film as a finished product.

Awards and Recognition:

- Awards will be given to the top 3 films based on the judges' scores.

- Additional awards may be given for categories such as Best Director, Best Cinematography, Best Story, etc.

- All participating districts will receive a certificate of participation.
