- ◆ Currently registered to the Boy Scouts of the Philippines;
- ◆ Physically fit as certified by the physician;
- ◆ Have a good leadership potential;
- ◆ Equipped with camping gears and must have a camping experience;

4. **Registration Fee**, a Non-refundable but transferable **registration fee of Three Hundred Fifty Pesos Only (350.00)** shall be charged from each participant. **No on-site** registration. **Deadline of payment will be on September 23, 2024**, as follows:

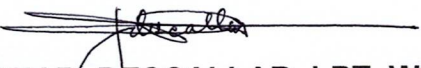

3. **Qualification/s** for participants are as follows:

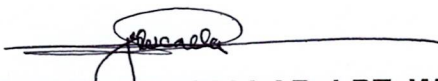
Scouts are expected to have leadership potentials, physically fit to undergo strenuous activity, and must be:

 - ◆ Have a good leadership potential;
 - ◆ Grades 4-6 Elementary (Boy Scouts);
 - ◆ Grades 1-3 Elementary (Kab Scouts); and
 - ◆ Must secure a parent's consent.
4. **Registration Fee**, a Non-refundable but transferable **registration fee of Fifty Pesos Only (50.00)** shall be charged from each participant. **No on-site registration. Deadline of payment will be on September 30, 2024.**
5. **Food provision.** It is suggested that each participant should be brought their packed lunch, emergency kit and extra clothes during the conduct of the activity.

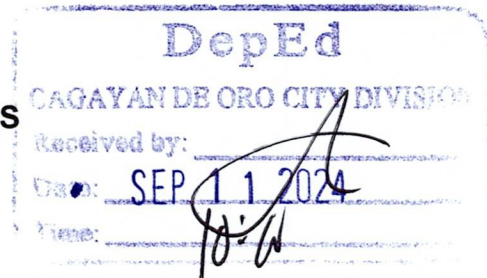

1. In consonance to DepEd order number 76, s. 2012 re: Revitalizing Scouting Movement in schools nationwide, and as per ***Division memorandum number 465 series of 2023*** the council are pleased to announce the holding of the **67th Jamboree of the Air (JOTA) and 28th Jamboree on the Internet (JOTI) and Council Wide Jamboree on October 18-20, 2024** with the theme: **"Youth Engagement: Sustaining Relevance and Strengthening Resilience."**

2. The main goal of JOTA-JOTI is to enable and encourage scouts around the world to communicate with one another by means of amateur radio and the internet, providing a fun and educational scouting experience and promoting their sense of belonging to a Worldwide Scout Movement. Likewise, through Jamboree, Scouts are rewarded for each achievement which helps them gain self-confidence.

3. **Qualification/s** for participants are as follows:

- ◆ Physically fit as certified by the physician;
- ◆ Have a good leadership potential;
- ◆ Equipped with camping gears and must have a camping experience.

B. Scouts are expected to have leadership potentials, physically fit to undergo strenuous activity, and must be:

- ◆ Currently registered to the Boy Scouts of the Philippines;
- ◆ Physically fit as certified by the physician;
- ◆ Have a good leadership potential;
- ◆ Grades 4-6 Elementary (Boy Scouts);
- ◆ Grades 7-12 Junior and Senior High School (Senior Scouts);
