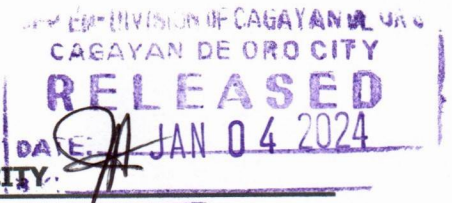

TRAINING**

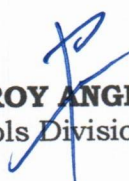

1. The field is hereby informed of the in-person robotics education training that will be held at the College of Technology of the University of Science and Technology of the Southern Philippines (USTP) on January 13, 27, February 10 and 24, 2024.
2. This robotics training is in partnership between DepEd Cagayan de Oro City and College of Technology of the University of Science and Technology of the Southern Philippines-Cagayan de Oro City. The said activity aims to provide teachers with the expertise to innovate and implement cutting-edge technologies, fostering proficiency in designing, programming, and optimizing intelligent robotic systems for real-world applications.
3. The official participants of this training will be the mathematics and science teachers who have been selected from public elementary and secondary schools that offer STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics), as well as schools that have special science programs (i.e STE, SSPS).
4. The participants involved in the training shall be granted with Service Credits/Compensatory Time-Off (CTO). This compensation is provided as a recognition of the commitment, diligence, and dedication of the trainees.
