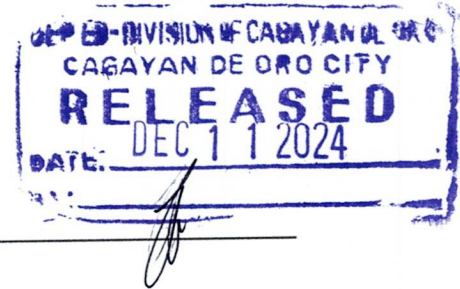

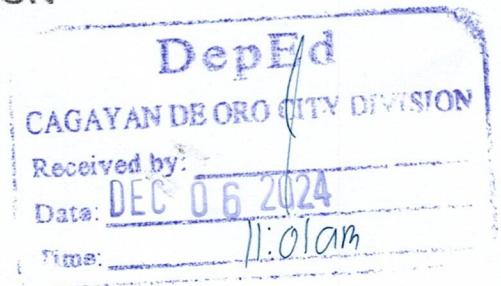

I would like to express my heartfelt gratitude for being our partner in providing relevant training to our education students through accepting them as student teachers in your schools every semester.

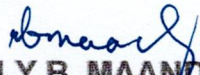
