INVITATION TO USTP SCI-MATH INDIGAY: SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS CONGRESS

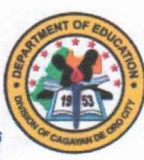

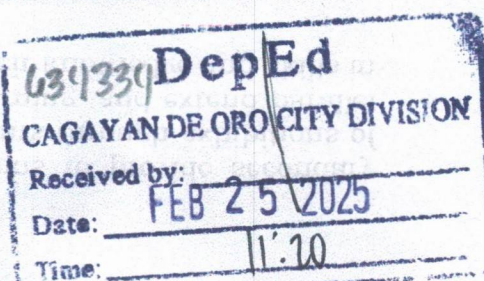
