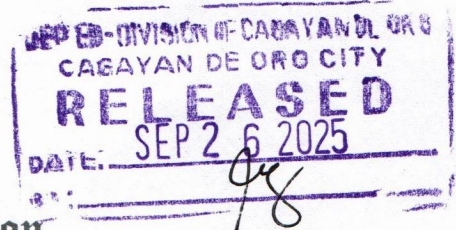

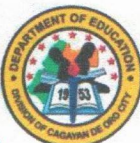
INVITATION TO MURAL PAINTING CONTEST

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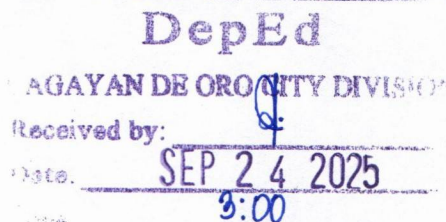

Event: MURAL PAINTING

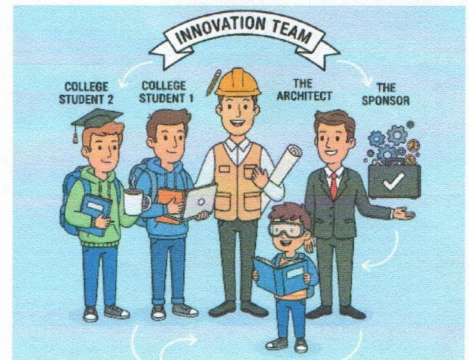
Venue: School Fence

Participants: UAP Architects, Sponsors, Arki Students (USTP & COC), Barangay staff, City Central Staff.

Sponsor: Triton

1. MECHANICS:

- 5 teams Consisting of 5 members shall create a mural in 1 of the bay of fence of the partner school.
- The teams must register 5 days before the event
- The contestants must plan and paint a mural that best represents the theme of the event. The mural must be accomplished within 4hrs.
- The theme must be given to the participants 2-3 days prior to the event so they can formulate a draft of the mural before painting on the actual day of the event.
- The teams will receive the following upon registration at the site:
 1. Name tags
 2. Paints, paint brushes, roller & used paper
 3. 1 bay of fence wall
- Winning participants (1st, 2nd, & 3rd place) shall receive a cash prize, certificates and giveaways from sponsors.



2. JUDGING:

- The murals shall be judged according to the criteria that will be provided during the event.
