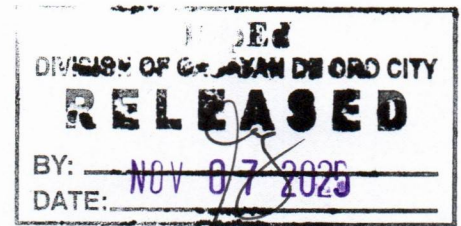

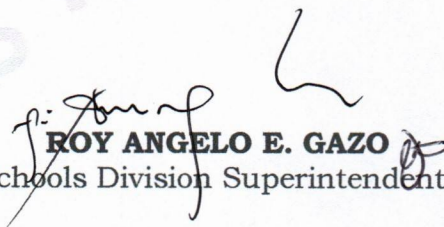

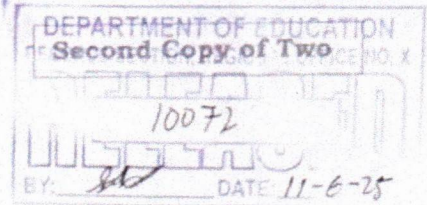
1. The training will be condensed, and participants are expected to check out on November 15, 2025.

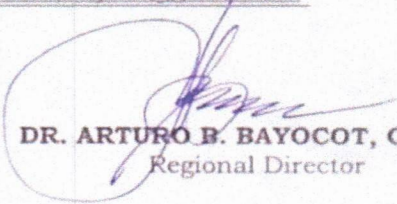
