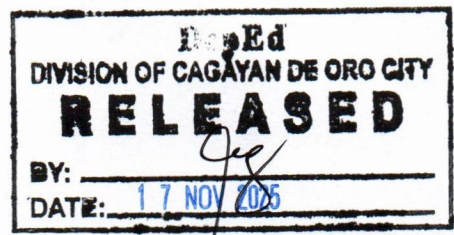

TRAINING ON MENTAL HEALTH GAP ACTION PROGRAM (mhGAP)

To: School Division Superintendents
All Others Concerned

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) Region X, in collaboration with the Department of Health (DOH), will conduct a **Training on Mental Health Gap Action Program (mhGAP)** at Deluxe Hotel, Cagayan de Oro City, on November 17-21.
2. The Mental Health Global Action Program (mhGAP), an initiative of the World Health Organization (WHO), seeks to address the burden of mental, neurological, and substance use (MNS) disorders. It equips health professionals with the competencies to integrate mental health services into primary health care, particularly in areas with limited specialized resources. Through mhGAP, the providers are trained to identify, manage, and refer individuals with common conditions such as depression, anxiety, psychosis, and epilepsy.
3. This training seeks to build the capacity of health professionals to provide responsive, effective, and compassionate mental health care, enabling them to better manage the rising cases of mental, neurological, and substance use disorders in the community.
4. **Hence, the Regional Office (RO) and each of the School Division Offices (SDOs) of DepEd X shall send one medical officer to participate in the training. Please confirm attendance on or before November 14, through this link <https://forms.gle/b5n4JiSritGp9WXV9>.** Kindly note that unconfirmed slots after the deadline will be reassigned to other interested participants.
5. Registration will open at 8:00 a.m., on November 17. Accommodation and meals during the training will be charged to the DOH-CHD-NM while transportation and other related expenses incurred outside the training dates will be charged to local funds, subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
