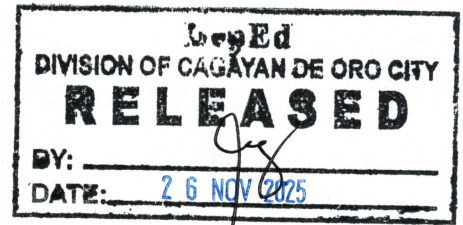

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**CIACAT-VAWC
LOGO MAKING CONTEST
MECHANICS**

1. The Competition is open to any medical related course of the invited school (1 entry with 2 participants per schools.
2. Participants must be a bona-fide student of the school represented and is required to send intent to participate to CSWD Office with the names of the 2 participating students and their contact details thru cdocswdo@gmail.com, on or before November 7, 2025.

Submission of the logo design will be on or before November 28, 2025. Selection and awarding of the best logo will be made during the culmination of the 18-day Campaign to End VAW on December 12, 2025.
3. Participants must use their own laptop or equipment.
4. The logo should include the name CIACAT-VAWC.
5. The logo must include dramatic and positive symbols that symbolize the functions of the CIACAT-VAWC. Be creative and also observe color combinations as it will be part of the criteria for judging.
6. Fonts used in the Entry logo will also be judged accordingly.
7. The logos can be created in any preferred editing application but make sure that it has its work file (jpeg or png) as it will be needed upon submission.
8. The participants should also give a brief description of the entry logo in English or Filipino. The description may include the essential meaning of the Entry logo and should defy all of the symbols that are embedded with the Entry Logo.
9. Participants should submit (3) files. The Original Work File of the Entry Logo (.psd, .jpg, .docx, or any in application), PNG file of the Entry logo, and the word file for the Entry logo's description.
10. The resolution of the logo must be in high resolution.
11. Use of AI-generated images is strictly not allowed.
12. Prizes:

Winner- P3,000; 2nd Prize- P1,500; 3rd Prize – P1,000.00; Consolation- P500

13. Criteria:

- Design and General appeal - 35%
- Originality - 20%
- Color Combination - 20%
- Depth of meaning - 10%
- Popularity (any FB reacts) – 15%



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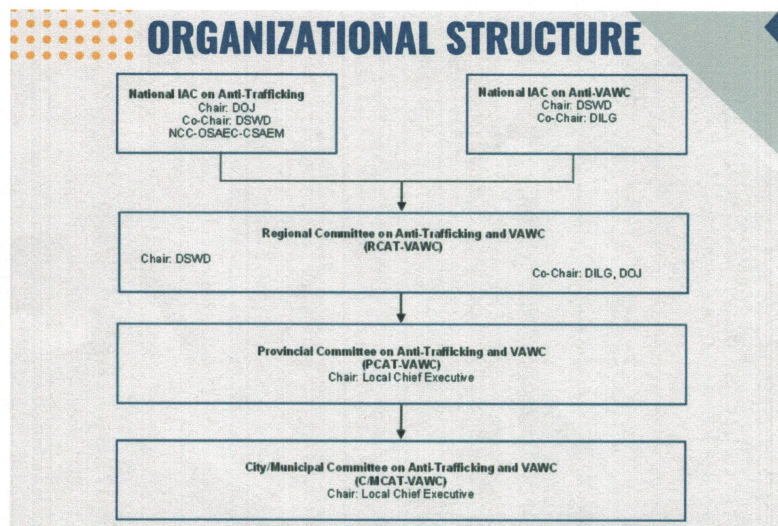


CIACAT-VAWC BACKGROUND

In October 18, 2010, the Department of Interior and Local Government, Department of Social Welfare and Development and Department of Justice issued Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2010-1 mandating the creation of Local Committees against Trafficking and Violence against Women and their Children (LCAT-VAWC). The general purpose of creating LCAT-VAWC is to establish and strengthen local structure that will collaboratively address the problem of Trafficking in Person and Violence against Women and their children (VAWC).

The said Joint Memorandum Circular likewise established an Organizational Structure for institutional arrangement and coordinating Procedures from the Local to National Level and Vice-Versa.

With its organizational Structure, the Inter-Agency Council against Trafficking and VAWC (IACAT-VAWC) serves as the National umbrella for Regional Committee on Anti-Trafficking and Violence against Women and their children, Provincial Anti-Trafficking and Violence against Women and their children and City or Municipal Committee on Anti-Trafficking and Violence against Women and their children.



On October 27, 2022, the City of Cagayan de Oro complied with the establishment of LCAT-VAWC through the issuance of Executive Order 112-2022 reorganizing LCAT-VAWC and named it as CITY INTER-AGENCY COUNCIL AGAINST TRAFFICKING, CHILD PORNOGRAPHY AND VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN AND THEIR CHILDREN or know as CIACAT-CP-VAWC.

Just last November 17, 2023 another issuance of Memorandum Circular No. 2023-181 was released by the Department of Interior and local Government that provides for the Guidelines on the Operationalization of LCAT-VAWC where new members are mandated to be included in its composition such as Children, OFW and Women Group to ensure that all functions of the Committee are being carried out.

Finally this years, 2025 the City Mayor issued the new Executive Order amending the previous Executive Orders. Consequently, the CIACAT-CP-VAWC was renamed to



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CIACAT-VAWC or City Inter-Agency Council Against Trafficking and Violence against Women and their Children.

Presently, the CIACAT-VAWC closely look into matters concerning VAWC, Trafficking in Person, OSAEC-CSAEM and other forms of Gender-based Violence in close partnership with the Barangays and other stakeholders.

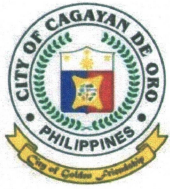

FUNCTIONS OF THE CIACAT-VAWC are as follows;

1. Recommend policies or measures to ensure effective implementation of RA 9208 as amended by RA 10364 and RA 11862, RA 11313, RA 11930 and other related laws and policies to protect women and children within its jurisdiction.

We are glad that our City Council have been enacting Local ordinances to protect our women and children. To name some, Ordinance No. 14332-2022 or the Protection and Support Mechanism for Survivors of Trafficking in Person, Child Pornography and Violence Against Women and Their Children and the Anti-OSAEC Ordinance of 2024, Ordinance 14879-2024 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR).

2. Recommend ordinance to implement local programs and related interventions on TIP, VAWC, OSAEC and CSAEM, GBSH in streets and public spaces and other forms of gender-based violence;

3. Institute policies and programs to protect women and children who are victims of trafficking, violence, sexual abuse or exploitation, sexual harassment, and other forms of gender-based violence (formulate or recommend local ordinances and resolutions)

4. identify communities and families that are vulnerable to TIP for purpose of providing appropriate interventions;

5. Undertake information, education and advocacy campaigns against TIP, VAWC, GBSH in the streets and public places, OSAEC and CSAEM and other forms of gender-based violence in the community and for the protection, recovery, and reintegration to the community of the victim-survivors;

6. Monitor and oversee the implementation of the laws;

7. Prepare the Annual Work and Financial Plan (AWFP) to serve as a guide to actions to be undertaken in order to effectively implement the duties and responsibilities of the LGU and attain the objectives of the laws.
