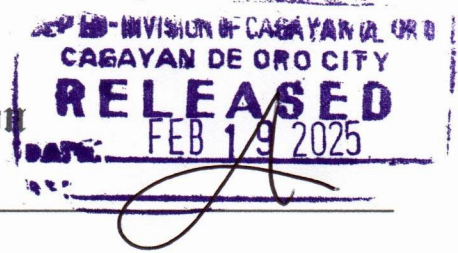

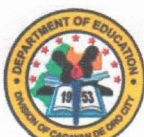
**PARTICIPATION IN XAVIER UNIVERSITY JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL'S
