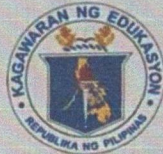

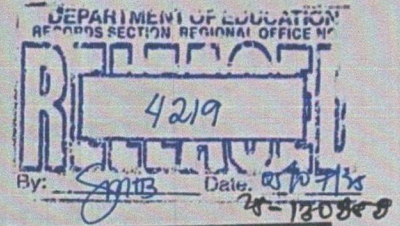

**IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CARE FOR THE NORMIN READERS (CNR)
DURING THE SUMMER ACADEMIC REMEDIATION PROGRAM (SARP)**

To: Schools Division Superintendents
All Others Concerned

1. Regarding **DepEd Order No. 010, s. 2025** or the **Guidelines for the Implementation of the 2025 Department of Education Summer Programs (ESP)**, this Office directs all school heads to offer Summer Remediation Program for Grades 4 to 12 learners from May 13 to June 6, following the Guidelines of the Care for the NorthMin Readers (CNR), to better support the learners and ensure their success in the next grade levels.
2. In implementing the CNR, as part of the ESP, the school heads of all schools in DepEd Region X may use the following materials, if deemed necessary:
 - a. The Literacy Remediation Program Materials (<https://bit.ly/lrpmaterials>)
 - b. Mathematics Manipulative Materials
 - c. The issued English Reading Kit to Schools
 - d. Books from the Library Hub
 - e. Other appropriate learning resources
3. The grouping shall be composed of a minimum of five and a maximum of 12 learners per class. The groupings of the learners shall adhere to the following reported data:
 - a. Comprehensive Rapid Literacy Assessment (CRLA)
 - b. Rapid Mathematics Assessment (RMA)
 - c. Philippine Informal Reading Inventory (Phil-IRI)
 - d. Overall Quarterly Performance rating of the learners
4. The CNR-ESP is voluntary basis for both teachers and learners. The school heads shall encourage teachers and learners to participate in the implementation of the program. All volunteer teachers shall receive Vacation Service Credits aligned with DepEd Order 013, s. 2024.
5. The school heads are expected to submit their Implementation Plan (see attached template) of the CNR-ESP on May 9, 2025. Also, the Division Focal Persons shall submit their monitoring plan of the different Education Summer Program duly approved by their Schools Division Superintendent (SDS).
