



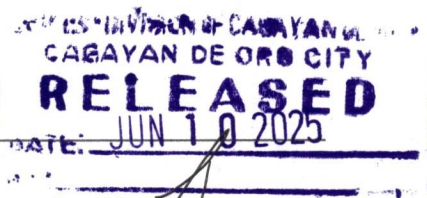

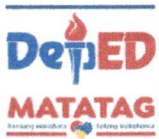

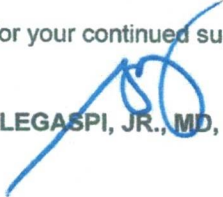
The **Violence and Injury Prevention Alliance (VIPA) of Cagayan de Oro City**, where the **Department of Education** is an active member, aims to strengthen its Information and Education Campaign (IEC) on road safety, particularly among school-aged children. This initiative stems from observed road crash incidents involving minor students, some of whom are not licensed to drive. In response, VIPA Cagayan de Oro City will be conducting a **Road Safety Forum** for high school students to educate and empower them on the importance of safe road practices.

The forum will be held from **June 24 to 27, 2025**, across **four selected schools** (one school per day), at a time convenient to each school. We kindly request your assistance in identifying and sending **student representatives per batch** to participate in the activity. The forum will run for **three hours** and will feature expert speakers from the **Cagayan de Oro City Police Office – Traffic Enforcement Unit (COCPO-TEU)**, who will discuss key topics such as pedestrian safety, responsible driving behavior, and traffic regulations. In addition, personnel from **CHDNM DOH-10** will conduct **hands-on CPR training** for participants. The forum will also include **interactive sessions and Q&A discussions** to encourage student engagement and active learning.

This initiative seeks to instill a culture of road safety among young individuals and to equip them with the knowledge and skills to stay safe on the road. We appreciate your continued support in promoting safety and well-being within our school communities.
