A. Testing Requirements

B. Testing Centers

Provision of a spacious and well-ventilated testing center equipped with functional computers and a strong, stable internet connection to facilitate the smooth conduct of the computer-based reliability testing of the developed Alternative Learning System (ALS) test items.

C. Takers

The learners must have prior experience in taking the ALS Accreditation and Equivalency (A&E) Test or have successfully completed the ALS A&E Program, as their background and familiarity with the assessment process are essential for generating valid and reliable results during the reliability testing of the developed ALS test items.

D. Focal Person

The assignment of a focal person or designated in-charge to facilitate the preparation and smooth conduct of the computer-based reliability testing. This includes coordinating logistical arrangements, assisting with participant management, and ensuring the proper implementation of testing protocols in alignment with DepEd guidelines.
