We also respectfully seek your assistance in reproducing the School Health Division forms, disseminating consent forms to parents/guardians and other relevant activities.

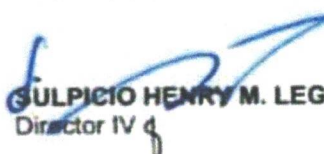
