**SAFERKIDSPH ONLINE SEXUAL ABUSE AND EXPLOITATION OF CHILDREN
(OSAEC) TRAINING E-COURSE**

TO: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent

1. In line with DepEd CDO's commitment to strengthen child protection mechanisms and promote safer online environments for learners, all public schools in the Division of Cagayan de Oro are hereby directed the complete composition of their School Child Protection Committee (CPC) to enroll in and complete the **SaferKidsPH Online Sexual Abuse and Exploitation of Children (OSAEC) E-Course**, developed in partnership with **Save the Children**.

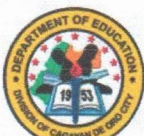
2. This e-course is designed to: (1) Raise awareness about the potential dangers that children may encounter online; (2) Provide practical tools and strategies to help keep learners safe in the digital environment; and (3) Guide school personnel and stakeholders on how to identify, prevent, and report abuse and exploitation to proper authorities.

3. Aligned with the CPC Functionality Assessment Tool, the completion of the course shall be considered as: (1) A capacity-building activity for all CPC members; and (2) A preventive initiative.

4. As provided under **DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012**, the school CPC shall be composed of the following:

- a. Chairperson – School Head
- b. Guidance Counselor/ Designate – Vice Chairperson
- c. Representative of the Teachers (designated by Faculty Club)
- d. Representative of the Parents (designated by the SPTA)
- e. Representative of the Learners (designated by the SELG/SSLG)
- f. Representative from the Community (a member of the BCPC)

3. Participants must register individually and complete the course modules. Once the confirmation email is received, the e-course may be accessed through the SaferKidsPH Learning Platform: <https://scp.castlms.com>. In cases where a CPC

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member or learner-representative is *under 13 years old*, the learner may use the email of their parent or class adviser to register and access the course.

6. All private schools within the Division of Cagayan de Oro are also encouraged to participate in this initiative as part of their child protection advocacy and continuing capacity enhancement.

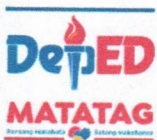

SAFERKIDSPH OSAEC AWARENESS TRAINING e-COURSE

Save the Children Philippines, along with UNICEF, The Asia Foundation, and the Australian Embassy, formed SaferKidsPH, a pioneering consortium created to reduce cases of online sexual abuse and exploitation of children (OSAEC) in the Philippines. SaferKidsPH works with children and their families, the Philippine government, civil society and the private sector to ensure that children are safe and protected online.

The e-Course is a set of comprehensive self-paced modules aimed at addressing the critical issue of OSAEC. These modules are designed to educate and empower children, adolescents, parents, and adults working with children to recognize, prevent, and respond to OSAEC. Each module is tailored to its specific audience, ensuring the content is age-appropriate, relevant, and engaging. A certificate is provided upon completion of the e-Course assessment.
