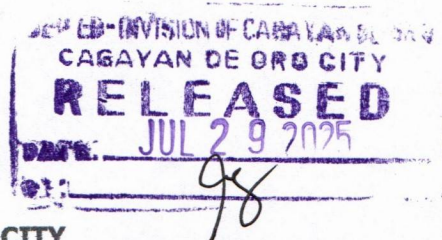

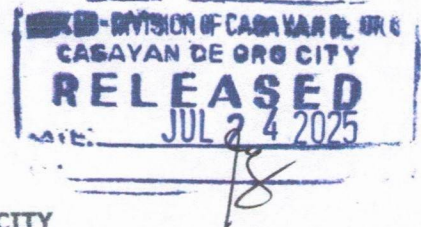

1. The selection procedure will be handled by school officials. No JCI member may participate in the recipients' selection process, directly or indirectly.
2. However, the following rules must be followed:

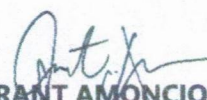
The YLEA award will be awarded to: (a.) one (1) **Class 2025 elementary graduate** and (b.) one (1) **Class 2025 senior high school students** and who has shown excellent academic achievements and leadership abilities via their scouts, varsity, interest groups, etc.) throughout their elementary or high school years.

3. *Please keep in mind that their academic and leadership experience isn't restricted to the present year; and may include prior experiences.*
4. The school principal/administrator shall issue a letter of recommendation for their awardee.
5. The selection committee from different schools shall have the freedom to set the specifics of the selection process of their awardees.
6. The evaluation form must be signed by the Selection Committee established by the school.

We will coordinate further with your office regarding the finalized venue and program details. The official awarding ceremony will be on the 29th July 2025, 2PM.
