This is a follow-up letter that was sent to your office last August 19, 2025 re invitation letter for the center's Drug Abuse Prevention and Control (DAPC) 2025 Closing Ceremony at Limketkai Center on November 21, 2025, Friday. As mentioned in the previous letter, we are inviting ten (10) schools with Teen Centers – (1) Kauswagan National High School, (2) Bayabas National High School, (3) Puntod National High School, (4) Iponan National High School, (5) Bugo National High School, (6) Lumbia National High School, (7) Lapasan National High School, (8) Consolacion National High School, (9) Bulua National High School and (10) City National High School. Moreover, on the closing ceremony, we are inviting ten (10) participants per school inclusive of their teachers and/or moderators.

Lastly, also as discussed with the previous letter, we are inviting these schools to participate in a video making contest on showcasing the Teen Centers accomplishment in drug education and prevention with the theme "Beyond the Influence: A Showcase of School Victories against Drugs". With a rating matrix of: (a) Relevance to the theme – 35%; (b) Creativity – 15%; (c) Story Telling – 20%; (d) Technical Quality – 15%; (e) Originality – 10% and (f) Audience Impact – 5%; with a **grand total of 100%**. The video must be **10 minutes long, landscape 1920 x 1080 pixel**.

Lastly, the panel of judges will select one (1) Teen Center to receive a special jury citation with a minimal cash prize; non-winners will also be receiving plaques and cash rewards.

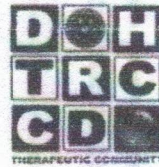
