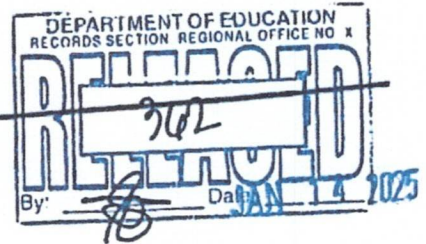

6. Private schools are also encouraged to participate, with the supervisor or focal person for private schools taking the lead in coordinating the involvement of students in this educational experience.

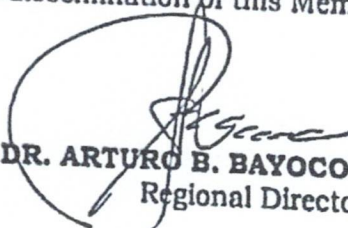
