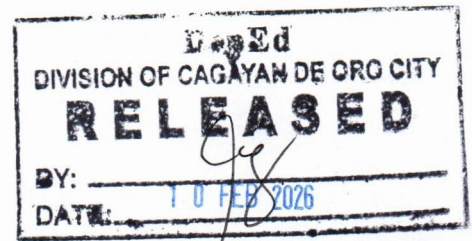

OBSERVANCE OF SAFER INTERNET DAY 2026 AND THE NATIONAL AWARENESS WEEK FOR THE PREVENTION OF CHILD ABUSE AND EXPLOITATION

TO: All Elementary and Secondary Schools
This Division

1. In line with DepEd's commitment to ensure a safe, protective, and child-friendly learning environment, all public and private schools in the Division of Cagayan de Oro City are hereby enjoined to actively observe **Safer Internet Day**, with the theme "Ako, Ikaw, Tayo: Konektado at Protektado laban sa OSAEC at CSAEM" and the **National Awareness Week for the Prevention of Child Abuse and Exploitation**.
2. The observance of Safer Internet Day, celebrated annually every February, aims to promote the responsible, safe, and positive use of digital technologies, particularly among learners, teachers, and parents. Meanwhile, the National Awareness Week for the Prevention of Child Abuse and Exploitation underscores the importance of strengthening child protection mechanisms and increasing public awareness on preventing all forms of abuse, violence, exploitation, and neglect against children.
3. Schools are encouraged to conduct age-appropriate and context-relevant activities, which may include but are not limited to the following:
 - Information dissemination and classroom discussions on online safety, cyberbullying prevention, and digital citizenship;
 - Webinars, orientations, or forums on child rights, child protection policies, and reporting mechanisms;
 - Poster-making, slogan-making, essay writing, or advocacy campaigns promoting child protection and safe internet use;
 - Parent and community engagement activities to reinforce shared responsibility in protecting children both online and offline.
4. School Child Protection Committees (CPCs) are directed to take the lead in planning, implementing, and documenting the activities, in coordination with teachers, learners, parents, and community partners.

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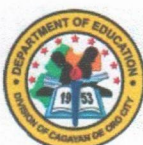
