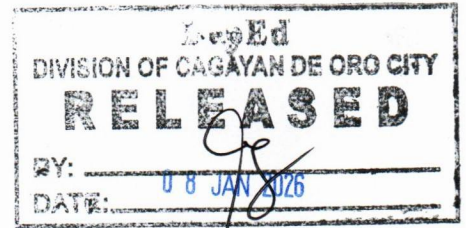

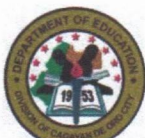
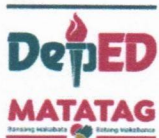

### I. FIELD STUDY 1 & 2 GUIDELINES

The Field Study 1 & 2 Program of PHINMA COC College of Education allows Field Study students (FSS) to immerse in an actual classroom situation and learning environment where direct observation of teaching learning episodes that focus on the application of educational theories learned in content and pedagogy courses will be made; and to participate and assist in a limited actual teaching-learning activities that relate to assessment of learning, preparation of instructional materials, preparation of bulletin boards and other routines in the classroom.

PHINMA COC Field Study Program regards this goal as venue for observing and assisting classes in a new normal setting that will provide the Field Study students (FSS) more opportunities for community involvement that can also actualize the institution's mission of making lives better through education as a manifestation of being good and responsive Filipino citizens.

The following as agreed by the parties hereto shall be observed:

- A. Field Study students (FSS) shall have its actual observation and teaching assistantship within January 12, 2026 to February 4, 2026 (*refer to the following specific dates presented below*):

- C. When a Field Study (FSS) student fails to render his/her area duty on the said dates, he/she will render extension duty hours to comply with the required number of duty hours for actual observation and teaching assistantship.
- D. Upon successful completion of the Field Study (120 hours), the Field Study student (FSS) shall be awarded a Certificate of Completion by the resource teacher.
