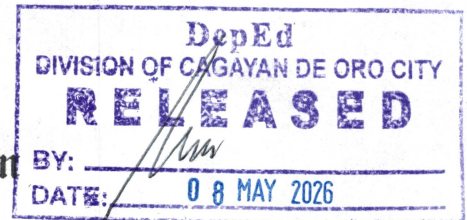

- Strengthened School-Based Mental Health Program that promote learners' mental health and wellbeing;
- The Learner Support Centers (LSCs) serve as integrated hubs providing academic, psychosocial, and assistance to learners. Managed by school heads and school counseling personnel, the LSC consolidates three key structures:
 - o **Care Center** – Pursuant to RA 12080, this center offers mental health and guidance and counseling services, including career guidance;
 - o **School-Based Teen Center (SBTC)** - A facility that supports adolescent reproductive health and education for the holistic development of learners. It also serves as a venue for the **Peer Support Program**, which addresses learners' overall well-being concerns, including physical health, mental health, and psychosocial needs.
 - o **Learner Rights and Protection (LRP) Helpdesk** – Reinforcing DepEd's zero-tolerance policy against all forms of abuse, violence, discrimination, and bullying among learners, the LRP Helpdesk aims to ensure that all concerns pertaining to learner safety, rights, and protection are appropriately addressed in accordance with existing laws and policies.
- LTCCH Expansion: The Learners TeleSafe Contact Center Helpline now operates in Regional Offices, providing learners, parents, and staff with accessible child protection support.
- Crisis Integration: A new two-way referral system between DepEd and NCMH strengthens mental health crisis response.
- Partner Collaboration: Enhanced coordination with LGUs and health providers ensures a more responsive learner support system.

All of these will be undertaken on **May 11, 2026** at Bulua National High School.

In this regard, this Office respectfully requests the **Schools Division Office of Cagayan de Oro City** to extend its full support and assistance in the following key areas:

1. Logistical arrangements for the event venue and participant movement;
2. Facilitation of invitations to the Local Government Unit (LGU) and other relevant stakeholders;
3. Coordination with the LGU on the Philhealth YAKAP Caravan;
4. Coordination with the LGU and partners for possible sponsorships;
5. Coordination with the LGU to ensure adequate security arrangements, including the provision of a standby emergency ambulance;
6. Procurement of food for participants and staff; and
7. Coordination for pre-event planning and on-the-day operational preparations.
