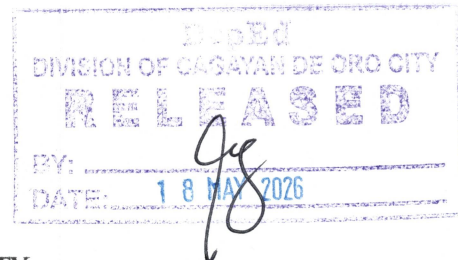

SUBJECT : **CONDUCT OF SCHOOL VISITS FOR THE MONITORING OF
2026 SUMMER REMEDIATION PROGRAMS**

DATE : May 14, 2026

1. In reference to DepEd Order No. 010, s. 2026, entitled "Guidelines for the Implementation of the 2026 Summer Remediation Programs", the Department of Education continues to address learning gaps through the ARAL Summer Program, Summer Academic Remedial Program, and the Senior High School Remediation Program from May 6 to June 2, 2026. In line with this, this Office will conduct monitoring visits in selected schools across all regions.
2. Specifically, the monitoring visits aim to determine the following:
 - a. the instructional and learning materials being utilized and the corresponding sources of procurement or funding;
 - b. the number of DepEd tutors and external tutors assigned per school;
 - c. the compensation arrangements and payment mechanisms tutors;
 - d. the actual attendance of learners during program implementation; and
 - e. other necessary information related to the implementation of the ARAL Summer Program.
3. The Regional Focal and Division Focals are requested to identify schools across classifications (e.g., central, last mile, urban, rural, pilot, and non-pilot Senior High Schools), covering all Key Stages and those implementing both ARAL Summer Reading and Mathematics.
4. The monitoring teams shall coordinate with the concerned Regional Offices (ROs), Schools Division Offices (SDOs), and school heads regarding the schedule of visits and other logistical arrangements, as indicated in the **Enclosure**.

5. The monitoring teams shall utilize approved monitoring tools and submit consolidated reports with findings and recommendations.
6. Expenses incurred relative to the conduct of monitoring activities shall be charged against the available FY 2026 Current and FY 2025 Continuing Basic Education Curriculum (BEC) Funds, or Local Funds as applicable, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
