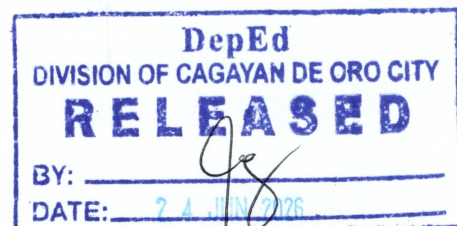

Pursuant to Republic Act No. 11510 (Alternative Learning System Act), and in compliance with DepEd Order No. 001, s. 2026 titled Implementing Guidelines of the Enhanced Alternative Learning System, the Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) shall conduct three (3) phases of monitoring activities for School Year (SY) 2026-2027 in select Schools Division Offices (SDOs).

The monitoring activities aim to comprehensively monitor and evaluate the implementation of the Alternative Learning System Program to collect ALS Key Performance Indicator data, identify best practices, optimize learning outcomes, and inform data-driven policy recommendations for continuous program improvement.

The assigned BAE monitors shall visit two (2) SDOs per region, including the SDO pilot implementing the Enhanced ALS Form 1 and another SDO to be identified by the Regional Office.

In this regard, Regional ALS Focal Persons and concerned Division ALS Focal Persons, with the assistance of the Education Program Specialists II for ALS, are requested to provide the necessary assistance and coordination to facilitate the conduct of these monitoring activities.
