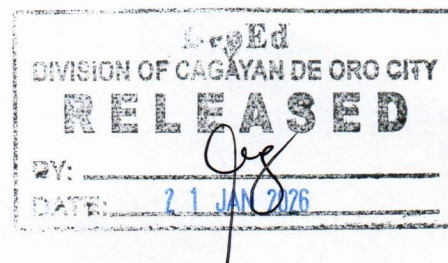

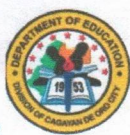
2. With this, the participating **TULONG DUNONG schools** are hereby requested to join the said activity.
