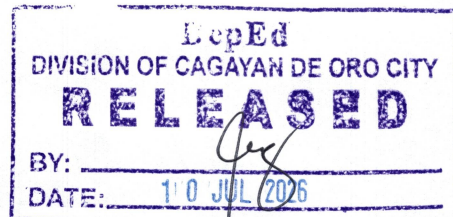

-Puerto National High School

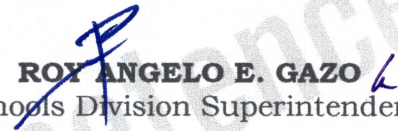

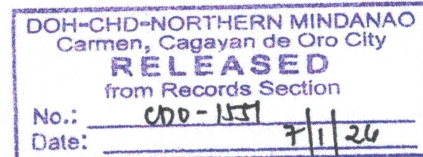
