The School of Education will be deploying our Field Study students to **Angeles Sisters National High School** for the secondary department, and **Consolacion Elementary School** for the elementary department. In deploying FS 1 (Observation of Teaching-Learning in Actual School Environment), students will be able to observe teachers and students, while FS 2 (Participation and Teaching Assistantship) students will be able to assist teachers. The said school will be providing a valuable opportunity for these future educators to gain hands-on experience in a real classroom setting.

The deployment dates will be from July 20 to Sept. 25, 2026. The FS students will be reporting every Monday, Tuesday and Friday from 8:00 am - 12:00 and 1:00 - 4:00 pm.

The FS 1 students will have the chance to observe different teaching methodologies, classroom management techniques, and student engagement strategies. This observation can help the FS1 students understand how theory translates into practice and provide them insights into the challenges and success of classroom teaching. However, FS2 students will be actively participating in classroom activities and assisting teachers in various ways.

Their involvement includes helping with classroom preparations, assisting learners during their lessons, and maybe they will be joining in small activities under the supervision of the classroom teachers (case to case situation). This kind of direct involvement can provide them with valuable skills and confidence as they prepare to become teachers themselves.

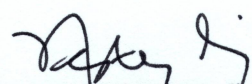
